District Wide Goals	 ELA: By spring of 2028, 80% of students will be at or above grade level on the NWEA MAP Growth assessment. The remaining 20% will show growth of 1.5 years. Math: By spring of 2028, 80% of students will be at or above grade level on the NWEA MAP Growth assessment. The remaining 20% will show growth of 1.5 years. Whole Child: By spring of 2028, there will be a reduction of suspensions and referrals across the district based on Infinite Campus suspension reports and referrals reflected in SWIS. 		
Building Wide Goals	 ELA Goal: Increase the percentage of students meeting or exceeding the NWEA grade-level mean RIT score in reading from 49.9% in Spring 2025 to 55% by Spring 2026. Math Goal: Increase the percentage of students meeting or exceeding the NWEA grade-level mean RIT score in math from 41.4% in Spring 2025 to 50% by Spring 2026. Whole Child Goal: Reduce the chronic absenteeism rate for both ML and non-ML students from 44% in Spring 2025 to 34% in Spring 2026, with targeted support for upper grades by Spring 2026. Increase student connectedness and engagement, as measured by a rise in PBIS Climate Survey scores from 2.73 to 3.0 and a 15% increase in club/event participation by Spring 2026. Improve school-wide behavior by reducing hallway/classroom referrals by 20%, decreasing skipping/tardy incidents by 15%, and increasing staff knowledge of office vs. classroom behavior procedures from 60% to 85% by Spring 2026. Improve family engagement by implementing consistent school-wide communication systems and increasing opportunities for meaningful feedback and partnership.
