

Norhill Neighborhood Association General Meeting Minutes October 28, 2025

Stephen Prescott, current NNA President, called the meeting to order at 6:35pm. Public service representatives were introduced and given time for announcements.

- Gary Collins, representing **Metro**, reminded participants at this meeting:
 - Metro provides free transportation to voting and to early voting.
 - Community Connector will start providing transportation from downtown Houston direct to IAH for \$450 one-way. Transport takes approx. 30 min.
- Thomas Wheaton representing **Council Member (Dist. H) Castillo**:
 - Trash pickup – Recycle is improving. Closer to consistent schedule
 - Speed Cushions: a lengthy process to get them installed, but N. Norhill cushions are “in the cue”. Dist. H staff will contact Public Works for updates if we ask.
 - Dist. H “Hot Team” will deal with illegal dumping. Call 311 first, then Dist H office.
 - Green Waste is now picked up with heavy trash: same day Still delayed about a week.
- Ms. Pam Foote, Houston Parks and Recreation temporary manager of Proctor Plaza: The annual Fall Festival for neighborhood children will take place here, at Proctor Plaza Community Center from 4:30 to 7 pm on Halloween. NNA has contributed financially to this event, as have local elected officials.

NNA Holiday Party will take place in December, but the exact date and place have not been determined. Members are encouraged to check website, email and Facebook for updates.

The Annual Operating Budget was presented and adopted by members present . There will be a heavy emphasis on bringing new members into the association. The budget was voted on and passed by a majority vote.
