The final project proposal is the opportunity for you to identify the study guide questions you plan to address and finalize the project you will use to address them. You will need to consider the tractability of the project. You should think about the time it will take to complete the project, the audience you are targeting, the cost of your project (**you are not required to spend any money on this project**), a timeline for implementing the project, and a backup plan should something go wrong. You will not be graded on skill (eg, I'm a terrible singer but could still do well on this project even if I wrote and sang a song way off key) but instead on demonstrating synthesis and mastery of the material. Feel free to email me or stop by drop-in hours to brainstorm. After you submit the proposal, I may request to meet with you to discuss the proposal before approving it.

You may complete this project independently or work with one other person from the class. **If you plan to work with someone, you must notify me via email before submitting this proposal.**
