Throughout this rotation, we concentrated on two major units. The first was diving into “Carnival of The Animals” by Camille Saint-Saëns. Students learned about what instruments sound like, and which family they are in. They learned some musical terms, including crescendo, the difference between smooth or separated notes, and forte versus piano (loud versus soft).

The second unit we studied was “Peter And The Wolf.” Kinders were able to mirror the study of all the musical terms we learned in the first unit, throughout this unit.

The Kinders were able to explore instruments such as the boomwhackers, rhythm sticks, Kalimba, and hand drums. We danced a LOT and even worked on choreographing some of our own works.
