

Using “Codes” in Mrs. Simon’s Class

How to appropriately identify your evidence for your answer.

If it is a Worksheet:

1. Answer the question in a restated complete sentence.
2. Highlight (do not circle, underline or any other method – it MUST be highlighted with a highlighter) where you found the answer. Make sure it is the BEST possible spot to correctly identify where you found the answer to that specific question, and only highlight the information you need to answer the question (DO NOT highlight an entire paragraph unless you need ALL of the information).
3. Put the number of the question next to the highlighted sentence(s) that it answers (ex: #3).

If it is in the Textbook:

1. Answer the Review Question in a restated complete sentence.
2. Find the page number and the paragraph number where you found the correct answer.
3. At the beginning or the end of your answer write the appropriate “code” of page number and paragraph number. (ex: 185-2 [This means you found the answer on page 185 and paragraph number 2 on that page]).
4. If you found the answer on a chart or diagram on a page, then write the page number and then “diagram” or “chart.” (ex: 185-diagram).
