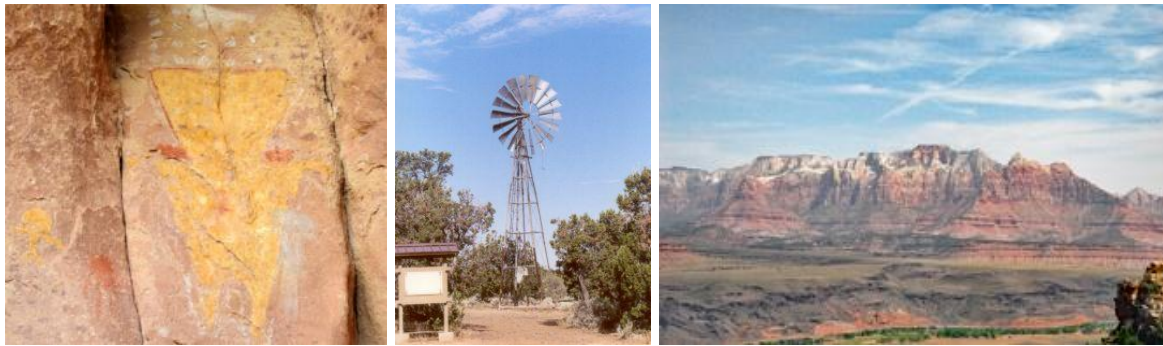


Photos from Gooseberry Mesa - Yellow Man and Windmill Trails - Wednesday, April 20
