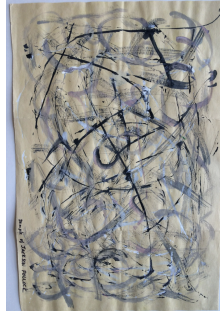
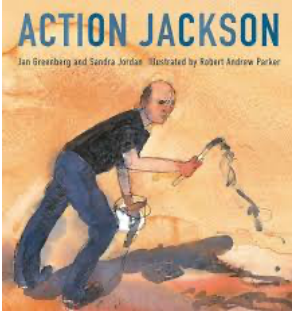


Talking Canvas



Artist: Jackson Pollock

Paper plates, paints, paintbrushes (an assortment for each kiddo), paper, book

Introduction

Touch base with teacher: Where is the best place for paintings to dry?

1. Have students sit at the carpet. One volunteer introduces our artist Jackson Pollock (show picture on the document camera), then read the book Action Jackson.
2. The other volunteers assist in getting materials ready (passing out paper, paints, and paintbrushes).

Activity

3. After reading ask: Why do you think they call him Action Jackson? **His paintings are done through action! Dancing, tossing, etc.**
4. Explain: Today we get to make our own paintings inspired by Jackson Pollock. Each of you will get one set of paints, a paper towel, a piece of large paper, and paintbrushes.
5. Before we go back to our table spot, lets think about what we might want to represent in our painting. It may be a place or a feeling like in Pollock's paintings.
 1. Show painting 1 on the document camera: **Look at this painting, it is called. What does it make you think of or feel?**
 2. Repeat with painting 2 and 3.
6. Now you get to decide what feelings or places you want to paint! Remember, our paintbrushes are tools not toys. We are going to do our best work and try to keep the paint on our paper. But remember, you can mix colors and make lines anyway you would like!
7. Dismiss students to their table spots.
8. All volunteers assist with students.
9. If students finish early they can have a piece of scratch paper and color using lines and movement like Pollock.
