On April 22, a patrol of two Mirage 2000D struck again, aiming at a logistics depot in the region of Al Qaim, Iraq

[Update for 20-26 April](#): Reports 18 strikes from 20-26 April: 13 ground support strikes – 6 strikes in the areas of **Mosul** and **Sinjar** and 7 strikes in along **the Euphrates valley**; 5 planned strikes – 3 strikes in the **Abu Kamal** area, **Syria** and 2 strikes in **Iraq**, one in the **Al Qaim** area and the second, a joint strike, in **Fallujah**, during the night of Sunday 24 to Monday 25 April, destroying important Daesh infrastructure.

[Update 29-30 April](#): *Reports 2 strikes – partnered with Coalition aircraft – on a major logistics site of Daesh in Al Qaim, Iraq: On April 29, around 21:30, four Rafale left the Arabo-Persian Gulf to join four Mirage 2000D from the deployed air base in Jordan. French aircraft, mostly equipped with cruise missile SCALP (long range autonomous conventional cruise system), were joined in the Iraqi skies by several fighters and US bombers (F15 and B52) to hit the targets that were set for them. On 30 April, the following night, another French-American system, consisting of two Rafale M2000D four and eight US aircraft, again hit the same logistics site of the terrorist organization.*

[Update 27 April - 3 May](#): Reports 15 strikes in Iraq: 13 ground support strikes and 2 planned strikes on 29 and 30 April, in the Al Qaim area against a center for

manufacturing improvised explosive devices and suicide vehicles.

[Update for 3-10 May:](#) Reports 17 strikes in Iraq destroying 37 targets: 15 ground support strikes – including striking 4 times within a few hours on 5 May in the Fallujah area – and 2 planned strikes – 3 May, a patrol of two Mirage 2000D conducted a raid in the area of Mosul against a Daesh military command post; on 9 May, a patrol of two Mirage 2000D struck near Kirkuk against an ammunition depot and a workshop used to assemble car bombs

[Update 11-17 May:](#) Reports 15 strikes in Iraq, destroying 22 targets, including 14 ground support strikes in the areas of Mosul, Ramadi and Fallujah and one planned strike: On May 13, a patrol of two Mirage 2000D, accompanied by coalition aircraft, conducted a raid in the area of **Rutbah** against a site held by fighters Daesh and also serving as weapons storage

Update from French MoD for on [20 May:](#)

[Reports that French aircraft participated between 13 and 19 May 2016 in the liberation of the city of Rutbah, in the province of Al-Anbar southwest Iraq: On May 13, a patrol of two aircraft, accompanied by coalition aircraft, conducted a planned raid (or Air Mission Prohibition) on a site run by Daesh fighters serving as a place of arms storage. On 16 and 19 May, Mirage2000D conducted support missions to ISPs, including destroying a piece of enemy artillery.]

Update from French MoD for [21 May:](#)

*[Reports that on May 21, 2016, a patrol of two Mirage 2000D conducted a planned strike (Air Prohibition) about thirty kilometers **south of Sinjar in northern Iraq**. An armored vehicle manufacturing site loaded with explosives was destroyed (vehicle-borne improvised explosive device). During the same day, the air support mission (CAS – Close Air Support) have succeeded in **the Mosul region of northern Iraq**, but also of **Fallujah in Anbar Valley**. All day, the Mirage 2000D took turns in the Iraqi*

skies, ready to strike in favor of friendly troops who request it. Aircraft of Chammal operation thus struck four times on the enemy lines, destroying fighting positions, heavy weapons and vehicles of the terrorist organization.]

Update from French MoD for [21-23 May](#):

[Reports that from 21 to 23 May 2016, Mirage 2000D have repeatedly hit Daesh, day and night. A dozen targets have been destroyed by two planned strikes and ground support missions conducted during the weekend]

Update from French MoD for [18-24 May](#):

*[Reports 19 strikes in Iraq, destroying 27 targets: 17 ground support strikes – with a focus on supporting ground operations in Mosul and Fallujah – and 2 planned strikes: On May 21, a patrol of two M2000D conducted a raid in the area of **Sinjar** against an armored vehicle manufacturing site loaded with explosives; on May 22, a patrol of 4 M2000D struck in **Fallujah** a weapons production site and explosive.]*

Update from French MoD for [28 May](#):

[Reports particularly intense activity on 28 and 29 May with 14 strikes carried out in less than 48 hours against Daesh fortified positions, command posts and logistics pads.]

Update from French MoD for [25-31 May](#):

[Reports 27 ground support strikes in Iraq destroying 31 targets. Efforts were centred around Mosul and Fallujah, with particularly intense activity on 28 and 29 May with 14 strikes carried out in less than 48 hours against Daesh fortified positions, command posts and logistics pads.]

Update from French MoD for [1-7 June](#):

[Reports three strikes destroying four goals against Daesh in Iraq]

Update from French MoD for [8-14 June](#):

[Reports 8 ground support strikes destroying 12 Daesh targets. This week Operation Chammal continued to support ground forces by Iraqi security

forces. Missions were carried out in Fallujah and also Sinjar]

Update from French MoD for [19 June](#):

[Reports that on 19 June, a patrol of three Mirage 2000D and a Mirage 2000N has made night a planned strike mission (air ban) **northwest of the city of Haditha** on the banks of the Euphrates. An important site of arms production was totally destroyed. The ban air missions are often conducted as part of Combined Air Operations (combined mixed air operations), which integrate devices and French allies on common goals. Besides the joint preparation between crews, these missions require great coordination in flight. On June 19, the French crews ensured the command of this combined air operation which, besides the Mirage 2000, included several allied aircraft. Hours later, a joint patrol of two Mirage 2000D and N intervened in support of ISPs, some **forty kilometers south of Mosul**. ISPs used the French aircraft, which hit enemy entrenchments and a mortar position twice, facilitating the progress of Allied troops.]

Update from French MoD for [15-21 June](#):

[Reports 12 strikes destroying 18 Daesh targets: 11 ground support strikes focussed around Fallujah and Mosul and 1 planned strike: On June 19, a patrol of 4 M2000 conducted a raid in the area of Haditha against a weapons production site.]

Update from French MoD for [24 and 25 June](#):

[On 24 and 25 June a 2000 Mirage stationed in Jordan conducted four strikes in support of the Iraqi armed forces in areas of **Ramadi, Fallujah and Mosul**]

Update from French MoD for [22-28 June](#):

[Reports 17 airstrikes destroying 38 targets: 14 ground support strikes in the areas of Ramadi, Fallujah and Qayyarah, and 3 planned strikes: June 25 in Iraq, a patrol of two Rafale carried out a strike in the Akashat region, destroying an assembly site and suicide vehicles. On June 28, in Syria, in the Abu

Kamal region, a raid of two Mirage 2000 and Rafale 2 conducted a strike to destroy an important Daesh training center. On June 28 in Syria, also in the Abu Kamal, a patrol of two Mirage 2000 conducted a strike against a Daesh firing position.]

5 July : French and **Belgian** aircraft conducted a night raid on a Daesh IED storage facility at Mosul. France conducted 9 strikes in total in Iraq between [June 29th and July 5th 2016](#)

Update from French MoD on 15 July:

'France reports 11 strikes this week (6-12 July) in Iraq and Syria, with 15 targets destroyed.'

Update from French MoD for [17 July](#):

[Reports that on July 17 in Mosul, two Mirage 2000D destroyed a significant headquarters Daesh, also serving as barracks and ammunition storage place]

Update from French MoD for [18 July](#):

[Reports that on July 18, in Mosul, a new raid by two Mirage 2000D and two Mirage 2000N targeted a Daesh complex of several buildings housing a headquarters, a training center for urban combat, and a warehouse of suicide vehicles. At the same, in Tal Afar, two Rafales destroyed a site of several buildings used as training center.]

Update from French MoD for [13-19 July](#):

[France reports six strikes destroying 11 targets from 13-19 July:

Update from French MoD for [28 July](#):

[France reports six airstrikes destroying 10 targets from 20-26 July]

Update from French MoD for [4 August](#):

[From 27 July to 2 August 2016, France reports eight strikes in Iraq, destroying 13 targets.

Update from French MoD for [August 12th](#):

[From August 3rd - 9th, France reports eight strikes in Iraq destroying 18 targets. Seven ground support strikes were carried out, including near Mosul and Qayyarah. In particular, on August 3rd 2016, a patrol of two Mirage 2000D accompanied by an Atlantique

The intervention of the French aircraft destroyed a dozen barracks and tunnels of a Daesh defensive system.
