Disclaimers

- I reserve the right to deny my services to anyone.
- My "flagship" characters (Fiera, Roshea, and Scott) are for my personal use only - requests to create "ship" art of them with a client's character will be denied.
- When discussing a commission please speak to me in a clear, professional, and objective manner. Because I am a professional artist, I do encourage and appreciate receiving constructive artistic critique.
 - Keeping this in mind, if I am spoken to rudely or made to feel uncomfortable, I do reserve the right to discontinue my work on your commission and issue a refund.
- All prices listed are subject to change based on the complexity of the commission, as well any amount of visual research I may need to gather if it is not provided to me.
- You must provide to me clear visual references, as well as clear and concise descriptions of your proposed commission ideas.
- I will provide work-in-progress (WIP) updates for each stage of my work progress: the rough sketch, lineart, flat color, and shading. I'll need your approval of each stage before I continue onto the next stage so that we do not miss any mistakes.
- The speed at which I may complete a commission may be fast or slow, depending on my personal health and well-being. I will provide updates in a timely manner, but please do check in with me if you do not hear from me after seven days from the last update.
- If you want your artwork to be completed within a deadline, please inform me prior to payment.
- If you want your artwork to be private (meaning I will not upload it to any galleries or social media,) I reserve the right to charge an additional 20% to the commission price.
- Giving and receiving art gifts is awesome! Please be aware that I require ***express permission*** from the recipient to draw their character(s). The best way of going about this is for me to have a discussion with the gift recipient, so that I can ensure they are comfortable with what is being drawn by me.

Art and Artistic Rights

- I reserve the rights to all the art I create and I may (or may not) use it in a variety of manner, such as:
 - Uploading to online galleries
 - Editing or cropping to use for promotion/advertisement, banners, etc.
- If I wish to sell physical reproductions of the artwork (ex. Prints, badges, cards, etc.) I will ask the commissioner for permission prior to doing so.
- The commissioner is free to share their artwork for personal use ONLY. If you wish to remain anonymous, please inform me in advance.
- When uploading the artwork to an online gallery or social media, please provide credit to me by tagging and/or sharing my profile(s).
- The artwork may NOT be used for commercial purposes and may NOT be resold by any means, unless it is discussed with the artist first - you may request to use your artwork for commercial purposes for an additional fee.
- Persons that are not the artist may NOT edit or remove my signature/watermark from their artwork.
- If the commissioner wishes to have another artist make changes to the artwork, please notify me in advance. *For example: if a black/white drawing is ordered and the client wants another artist to color the drawing, I will gladly send the working file (.PSD or .clip) to the artist coloring the image.*
- The commissioner is permitted to edit their artwork for the purpose of making avatars/banners, so long as credit is given to me.

Payment

- I accept payments via PayPal in USD. Once I give you a quote for the price of your commission, I will require your email address so I may send you an invoice.
- Payment for your commission is due up front.
- For convenience, I can offer a payment plan for commissions over \$150.

Corrections and Changes

- If there are any mistakes or missed details that I have made, they will be changed for free, *granted that they are my own fault.*
- Up to three corrections or changes to the base drawing may only be done for free, so long as this is prior to me beginning the shading process.
- Corrections made after the shading process will incur an additional charge of \$5 each.

Refunds

- If I am unable to complete your commission, I will issue a full refund.
- If you wish to be issued a refund:
 - If I have not begun to work on your commission, you will receive a full refund.
 - The amount that may be refunded will depend on the amount of work done on it.
 - If your commission is considered complete, then no refund shall be granted.
 - I retain full rights of the artwork in progress if you do get a refund.
 - Filing for a dispute/chargeback via PayPal or your credit card company (without contacting me first) will result in a permanent block; warnings will be filed to ArtistsBeware, as well as broadcasted to other artists in my community.

Things I love to draw:

- Werewolves (and other carnivorous were-beasts)
- Dragons and scalies
- Demons
- Aliens, parasites, symbiotes
- Anthro and feral (note: for NSFW artwork of feral characters, the character MUST be capable of higher thought processes, for example, a feral werewolf still retains their human consciousness)
- Light bondage, rough play (bruises, marks, light blood is okay)
- Romantic mushy stuff
- Breeding, impregnation, pregnancy
- Couples - straight (MF) and lesbian (FF), monogamy
- Rule 34 - there are some things I refuse to do fanart of, please contact me if you have any questions.
- Transformation – I am a purist; so it's easier to tell you what I don't enjoy, listed below...

Things I'm willing to draw on occasion:

- Familial, wholesome, cute stuff
- Couples - gay (MM) and other genders that lie outside the MF binary; polygamy, infidelity
- Threesomes, group sex/orgies
- Heavy bondage, latex/slime/goo
- Paw stuff
- Marine animals, Ungulates (hooved animals), Aves, Rodents, Insectoids, Arachnids
- Transformation with dubious consent (context needs discussion)

Things I refuse to draw:

- Underage characters - loli, shota, cub, etc.
- Incest
- Any act that is non-consensual
- Scat, watersports, diaper
- Vore, heavy gore/guro
- Hyper anything
- Race fetishization
- Bestiality
- Discrimination, racism, etc.
- "Spirit animals"
- Other canonical art styles, including but not limited to franchises such as Pokemon, Digimon, MLP, etc. I draw in my own style and I do not want to imitate styles that are not similar to my own.
- Transformation - gender (TFTG), inflation, inanimate, body part, racial, identity death, bimbofication, and other weird/strange "trendy" TF
- Robotics, mecha
- Bare breasts, nipples, and areolae - this is triggering for me and causes me emotional distress. Breast cancer sucks.

Please be respectful of my choices of what I do and do not draw. Attempts to debate my choices in what I do or do not want to draw will result in a block.
