More suggestions

- On the publish page, we could mark the availability responses grid to show which times have been blocked based on the events
- Add host on event cards on dashboard
- LOGO IDEA
 - Calendar icon with shortened version of name (once we decide) with 28 as the date on the top right
- Note about event card on publish events
 - The way the info is laid out got me confused for a split second
 - I would look at the times but since the times are the same, it made me think they were coming from the same date
 - It would help if the date was closer to the time → essentially switch order of time and date

All UX suggestions to complete for user testing

- On the publish page, we could mark the availability responses grid to show which times have been blocked based on the events
 - based on the hosted users' events? or should that be on the availability grid in the first place? hm

- Swap position of event title and date on publish event page ✓
- Optional: iterate over the availability grid view
- Add host on event cards on dashboard
- Instead of showing available people at the top of availability grid, just have a popup on hover / click
- On the create page, there should be an indicator that the calendar can be edited and that it is required
 - Add a label on top that says, "What is the date range of the schedule?"
 - Edge case: if only one day is selected
 - There can be a toggle underneath the calendar that says "one day schedule?" (default no)
 - If yes → end date = start date and disable calendar from being changed
 - If no → range is required and have error message show up after submit if no end date
