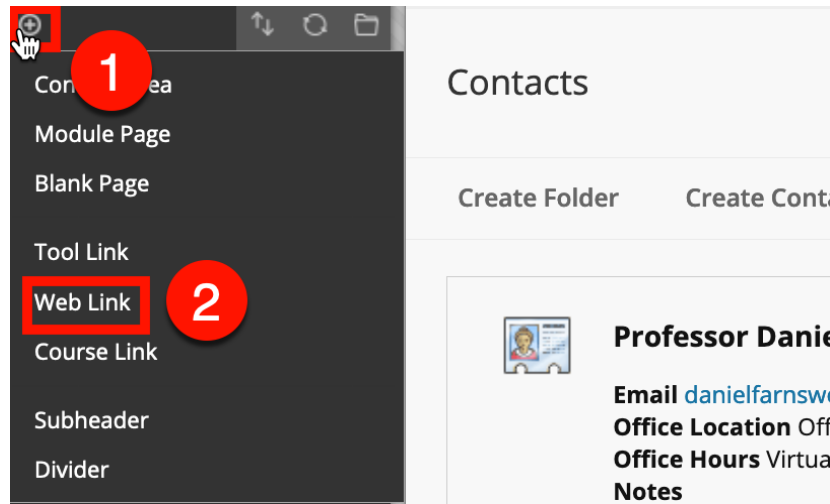


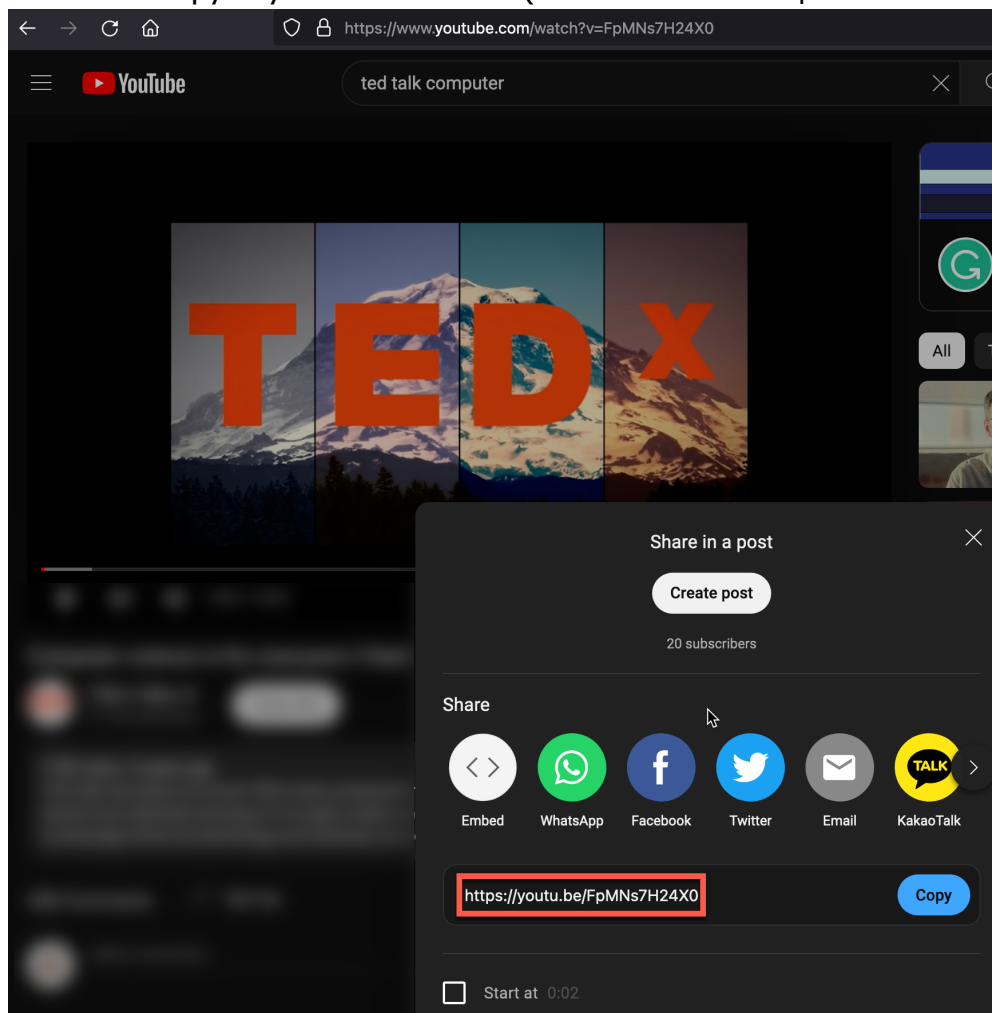
How to Add a Web Link to Video

Enter a Blackboard course.

1. Hover your mouse over the “+” above the left course menu to open a drop down menu.
2. Select **Web Link**.



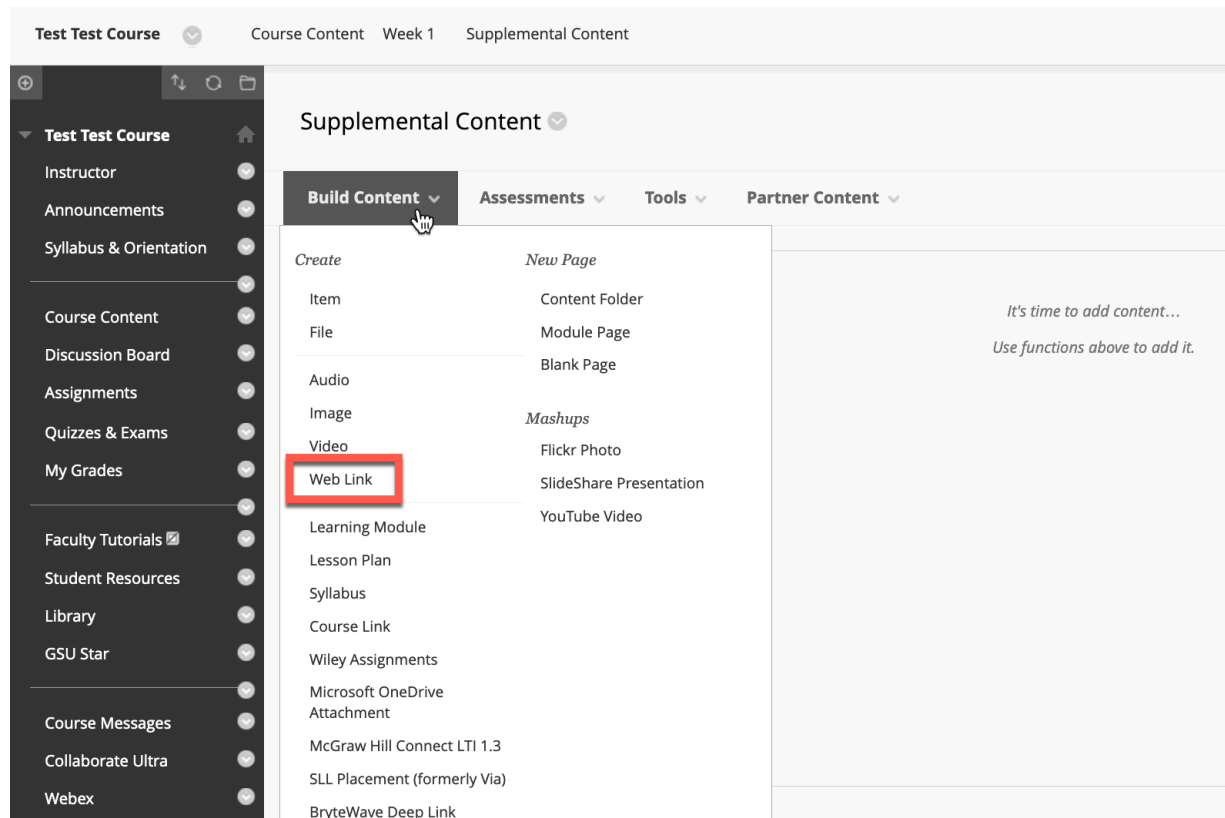
Proceed to the webpage where you would like to copy the URL from. Highlight the URL and select right-click copy or use the copy keyboard command (Mac: Command-C | Windows: Ctrl+C).

Proceed back to Blackboard. Select the content area you would like to add the video to. Select Build Content > Web Link.



The Create Web Link page should appear. Enter a Name, URL, and check Available to Users. To paste the URL in the URL field, you may select right-click paste or use the copy keyboard command (Mac: Command-V | Windows: Ctrl+V). Once you are finished, click Submit to save the changes.
