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## Point Title One: Post-Hackathon Amplification

Label: **Event** ▾

**Notes:** The Marketing Circle supported the amplification and visibility of both hackathons held in India and Nigeria. Our efforts focused on diffusing awareness across channels, ensuring consistent messaging before, during, and after the events.

Support included promotional campaigns to attract participants, real-time coverage of the live events, and the creation of content materials tailored for social media and broader ecosystem communication. This included short videos, graphics, captions, announcements, and post-event highlights designed to extend the reach and impact of each hackathon beyond the in-person experience.

Through coordinated communication efforts, the Marketing Circle contributed to strengthening engagement, increasing visibility for participating teams, and positioning the initiatives within the broader ecosystem narrative.

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## Point Title Two: Agentic Ideation Challenge

Label: **Event** ▾

**Notes:** The Marketing Circle supported the Agentic Ideation Challenge through a coordinated communication campaign designed to drive awareness, attract participants, and increase overall sign-ups.

Our efforts included the development and distribution of promotional content across social media channels, clear messaging around the challenge's objectives and value proposition, and strategic amplification to reach relevant audiences within the ecosystem. The campaign was structured to maintain momentum throughout the challenge lifecycle, from announcement to reminders and closing communications. This effort resulted in 140+ ideas submitted and an opportunity to promote ASI Create with the 20 finalists who received early access to the platform.

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### Point Title Three: X Spaces

Label: **Milestone** ▾

**Notes:** The Marketing Circle maintained contributions to the recurring biweekly X Spaces campaign. The Circle supported the Events Circle in promoting and amplifying each session. This included campaign planning, promotional copy, graphic production, scheduling support, and post-event visibility to extend the reach beyond the live broadcast.

Through this structured, recurring effort, X Spaces has recorded approximately consistent 20% growth in both its communication channel and community building, with over 70 live listeners at the most recent event.

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### Point Title Four: MatterMost Bot Campaign to solve the 40% reduction in retention on the website and create a deployment-ready dev database for Partner RFPs, projects, etc.

**Notes:** Designed a three-month strategic roadmap for community engagement using a bot for the public Mattermost channel aimed at vetting the public MM channel community members and identifying their level of developer seniority and ASI tech stack readiness. The bot replaces the initial general trivia with technical challenges (e.g., architectural problems and RFP-related questions) and rewards correct responses with 'Reputation Points.' While it was not deployed, the concept is now being adapted to align with SNET's needs and will be submitted as a proposal for potential project funding.

### Point Title Five: Global UTM & Event Attribution Framework

**Label:** New Initiative ▾

**Notes:** Implementation of a Global Attribution Framework to Standardize UTM and Enhance DEEP Platform Event Tracking. This initiative establishes a "source of truth" for cross-channel performance, enabling precise conversion analysis and data-driven optimization of social media activities and web traffic.

**Point Title Six: Shift from hourly-based to project-based**

**Notes:** The circle in the last two months has been trying to define part of our efforts that could be modeled into a project. While still at it, we have encouraged members to explore the ASI ecosystem tech stacks and then submit project ideas. 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## Point Title One: X Space

**Notes:** We have already supported 3 X Spaces by designing banners, and promoting them across social media and MM channels. Gael has assisted with all aspects of the campaign, contributing to decision-making.

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## Point Title Two: Youtube Strategy

**Notes:** Priscilla and Gael have developed a YouTube strategy to be implemented starting next month from September 2025–January 2026, based on 3 pillars:

- Consistency & Predictability
- Content Diversification & Optimization
- Community-Driven Engagement

Regular posting days have been established, with the “Premiere” option implemented to build anticipation and create expectations. Content will include tutorials, interviews and conversations, event recaps, as well as short-form clips and YouTube Shorts to keep the channel dynamic and varied. To drive engagement, we will incorporate interactive calls to action, feedback loops, and cross-promotion across platforms.

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## Point Title Three: Community Engagement Challenges Update

**Label:** Challenge ▾

**Notes:** We are relaunching the *Finding the Word* challenge, originally developed and hosted by Robel on Telegram for three months. Since it successfully engaged the community, we are bringing it back. The *Storytelling Challenge*, developed by Abdul, has been adjusted and will soon be launched on X Spaces. In addition, we are introducing a new challenge, created by Kenichi, to activate the Public MatterMost channel.

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### **Point Title Three: Code of Conduct workshop**

**Label:** New Initiative ▾

**Notes:** We hosted the first part of the workshop with the members of the Marketing Circle to create a code of conduct. Together, we defined the core values that represent us, identified the behaviors we want to encourage, and discussed how to address potential issues. The second part of the workshop, where we will finalize the document, will be held soon. Overall, it was a fun and valuable activity that helped bring the members closer together.

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### **Point Title Three: Internal Newsletter**

**Label:** New Initiative ▾

**Notes:** It was decided to create an Internal Newsletter to communicate decisions and news to Circle members. Ana and Beatriz prepared a document to define which topics should be included in the Internal Newsletter and which should go to the External one. The document was shared with the three Marketing Circles, and as a result, all of them provided input on the processes Marketing should follow to gather the information for each category.

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### **Point Title Three: Perception Survey “Marketing internal workflow”**

**Label:** New Insight ▾

**Notes:** Oscar helped develop a survey for the Marketing Circle to assess their perception of the recent adjustments in processes and workflow over the past six months. The results showed that using a content calendar has helped keep tasks organized, while the new content strategy team structure and weekly calls have improved coordination and kept everyone updated. Team members have also grown more confident in their roles as communication and collaboration have increased. Regarding task distribution, we found that allowing each member to initially select two tasks, and waiting 24 hours before choosing additional ones, gave members in different time zones a fair opportunity to participate. Finally, collective and transparent decision-making, conducted anonymously and unanimously on important matters, has proven to be an effective approach.

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### Point Title Three: Bluesky platform

Label: **New Initiative** ▾

**Notes:** An anonymous survey was conducted within the Content Strategy team to decide whether to add Bluesky to our current social media platforms. The results showed 5 out of 6 in favor, so we will implement the same strategy we currently use for X, at least for now, until we gain a better understanding of how the platform performs.

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### Three: AI For Good Campaign

Based on these insights, we're developing a new content strategy tailored to each audience, ensuring we deliver relevant, engaging, and impactful content across all platforms.
