Daniel's Table MassBay Framingham frozen meal program for students experiencing food insecurity (not having access to sufficient food, or food of an adequate quality to meet one's basic needs)-Students are required to schedule an appointment with the Resource Specialist, Marybeth Fletcher or Food Coordinator, Jenny Cavallerano to qualify for the program.

Students will be asked to choose one day of the week they would like to pick up their weekly meals and a referral will be made to Student Services. The sign-up (QR code located on the front desk) must be completed once a week at time of pick-up. The Daniel's Table freezer is located on the 3rd floor of the Framingham campus in the Student Services suite. Please ask someone at the desk or in the suite to assist you. Meals are available M-Th 9am-6pm. The QR

code to sign up for the meals is taped to the front desk or you can use the link below. You must register for the meals weekly and pick up is limited to once a week. Students may take a family meal (serves 4)- 1 protein pack, 2 packages of frozen vegetables, 1 box of rice or pasta (located in bin on top of freezer) and 1 quart size of soup or up to 5 individual meals (protein, carb and vegetable) and pint size soup per week.
