Entry & Dismissal Times: As you are aware, our morning and end of days can be very busy with children both entering buses, walking home and getting picked up. During these times, we ask that you please avoid standing/parking at the bus loading zones, as we need to ensure our students are safe. To reduce as much congestion as possible, we also ask that if your child rides the bus to and from school, that they continue to do so daily. If for some reason your child will not be on the bus on a given day, we ask that you notify your child's teacher or the office to ensure everyone gets home safely. Lastly, please note that supervision in the mornings begins at 8:20am.
