Callback pick up is also in the **FRONT** of the building. The callback list and further callback information will be emailed to contacts on October 31st. Not being asked to callbacks does not mean you aren't in the show. The final cast/crew list will be emailed to contacts on November 5th.

On the other side of this paper is a contract. It is very important that all families understand that not all students can be a part of this production, and the time commitment needed for rehearsals should your student be selected for the school musical. Please review the rehearsal schedule, tech week schedule, and show dates in the audition packet on our WAMS Theater Website. Please list any activities/conflicts on the back of this paper that will conflict with our rehearsals/tech/shows, and sign. **STUDENTS MUST BRING THIS SIGNED FORM BACK TO THEIR AUDITION.**

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS	
STUDENTS	PARENTS / GUARDIANS
#1 - Prepare & perform one of the audition songs provided on the theater website.	Submit the Audition Form (Google Form) found on the theater website. <i>This online form states that all parents/guardians have reviewed the musical policies and the contract. This form is <u>NOT</u> to be filled out by students.</i>
#2 - Perform the dance learned at the Dance Workshop.	
#3 - Wear sneakers or dance shoes and comfortable clothes to dance in for auditions. - No boots or sandals.	

While you wait: Cell phones are not permitted while waiting for your audition. You may use your cell phone to call home once your audition is through. You may use your school computer to complete HW. You may pack extra water and dry snacks.

Student/Parent Contract

Carefully examine the rehearsal time frame on our website. Make a note of any potential conflicts you may have with dates and times, and please explain where necessary on the lines below. Include any activities, lessons, appointments, etc. Some may be able to be worked around, others may not, but the earlier they are known, the better for all involved. **Pre-planned conflicts not communicated are grounds for removal from scenes/numbers.**

1. **I understand that not all students who audition can be cast in the show.** I understand that previous participation in the school musical does not guarantee a spot in this year's musical. **I will respect the casting choices of the musical staff.**
2. If cast, I will stay on top of my classwork and maintain good grades. Failure to receive passing grades at school may result in removal of the show.
3. If cast, I will demonstrate good behavior in school. Any negative disciplinary action at school may result in removal of the show.
4. If cast, I will attend rehearsals and be prompt in learning lines, songs and/or responsibilities required for my part/role.
5. If cast, I will be picked up promptly at the end of each rehearsal in the front parking. **More than two late pickups are grounds for removal from scenes/numbers.**
6. If cast, I understand that attendance at rehearsals are vital to the success of the show. I have reviewed the rehearsal schedule, rehearsal policies, and tech week schedule in the audition packet on the website. If I have any conflicts, I have listed them on this paper and on the Google Form.
7. If cast, I am aware that I may need to purchase/provide my own costume basics (t-shirt, undergarments, footwear, tights). *Aid is available, so financial concerns should not be a barrier for student participation.
8. If cast, I will follow all musical policies for attendance, dismissal, rehearsal attire, the use of valuables/cell phones, and behavior during school and rehearsals.
9. If cast, I will be present for Tech Week and all performances.
