

PROJECT: COVER OF A NEWSPAPER

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Project **in pairs** that consists of making a **COVER OF A NEWSPAPER** that deals with different topics seen in this trimester.
 - You must invent **news extracts** about **real events**.
- 6 MUST-HAVE TOPICS:
 - **REVOLUTIONS OF THE 19TH C.**
 - **INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTIONS**
 - **RELEVANT WOMAN FROM THIS PERIOD**
 - **ART OF THE TIME**
 - **SPAIN**
 - **FIRST WORLD WAR**
- Pairs **MUST** clearly **DIVIDE** the work, even if you make mutual decisions.
- It can be **BY HAND** or on the computer, in a **PRESENTATION** program (Canva, PowerPoint...).
- THE **FORMAT** must be **IN VERTICAL, FOLIO SIZE**.
- In **ENGLISH** (grammar mistakes won't be considered)
- It must consist of:
 - **NEWSPAPER TITLE** (made up)
 - **EXTRACTS FROM NEWS, ABOUT REAL ACTIONS, WRITTEN BY YOU BOTH.**
 - **IMAGES (IN MOST NEWS)**
 - **ON A SEPARATE PAGE:**
 - **FULL NAME, GROUP.**
 - **WEBGRAPHY**
 - **DIVISION OF TOPICS BY PAIRS.**
- You will work in **CLASS**.
- Delivery date: **FRIDAY DECEMBER 13**

NEWS CHARACTERISTICS:

- They must be **REAL EVENTS**.
- You will add a **HEADLINE** that explains the main idea of the news. This can be an objective headline or one that tries to grab the reader's attention.
- You must add at least one **PARAGRAPH** that briefly explains the news under the headline (the so-called "**LEAD**", as we see in a current newspaper). You must explain the **WHAT, HOW, WHEN, WHO, WHERE** and **WHY** in those paragraphs.
- You will use language typical of a newspaper: direct, clear and simple language.
- They must be well written, without spelling mistakes.
- Try to use creativity to make people want to read your newspaper.

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:		
ELEMENTS TO EVALUATE	WEIGHT	CRITERIA
CONTENTS AND HISTORICAL ACCURACY	70%	Treat all content with historical correctness and in a clear way. Uses proven historical vocabulary. The sources and images are correct. No “copy and take”.
SPELLING AND GRAMMAR	10%	No spelling mistakes. Comprehensible text No use of “translators”.
STYLE AND FORMAT	5%	Format appropriate to the news. Good layout of text and images.
FOLLOWING THE INSTRUCTIONS	5%	It deals with all the required points (language, content, format, bibliography...) Delivery in data.
ORIGINALITY	5%	There are creative ideas, which bring innovative and unique elements to the project.
ATTITUDE AND WORK	5%	Good attitude and behavior in the classroom. Ask questions and work actively.
