Audition Information

Thank you for your interest in auditioning for *Radium Girls*! Please read this page so that you are prepared for your audition. If you have any questions or concerns, please see Ms. von Jena, Ms. Keenan or Mr. Herbst **before the audition day**! We are more than happy to help! For auditions, we are looking for 7th and 8th grade students to show their acting talents, but also their personality and stage presence. This is a real and emotional show that requires actors to be expressive on stage.

When - Video submissions are due through the website below by **5:00 pm on Monday, September 7th**.

If necessary, callbacks will be Tuesday, September 8th. *If you do not receive a callback, it does not mean you will not get a part.* Callbacks are a time for the director to explore talents further or see who may be a best fit with other actors.

The Cast List will be posted online by the end of the day on Wednesday, September 9th and the first rehearsal will be THURSDAY, September 10th (this will be a full-cast rehearsal). A rehearsal calendar will be shared at that first meeting.

Performance dates are Friday, October 23rd and Saturday October 24th

What - In order to be successful, you must go to this website for all things you will need for the audition:

Click on the “Radium Girls” section. Everything you will need to be prepared is found online. You will need to register and then learn and memorize two monologues. You will find character descriptions and information about the show itself. We will also be posting callback and cast lists, as well as information on the audition webpage. **If you do complete the tasks on this sheet, you will not be able (or prepared) to audition.**

Please complete the following action steps before the audition.

1. **Read the [show summary and character descriptions](#).** The more familiar you are with the show, the more you will understand what we are looking for.
2. **Learn and record two monologues.** There are six possible [options for monologues](#) from the show. Select your two monologues to **memorize** and record as your audition. Beyond memorization, we are looking to see the personality of the character come through the words you are saying - make sure to add vocal inflection, movement, and gesture to your performance.
3. **Register and Submit Your Audition.** You will need to fill out the [google form](#) found on the website to sign up and audition. Please be honest and detailed when you complete the form. Part of the form requires uploading the recordings of your two monologues and a picture of a signed copy of our [Actors Contract](#).

The more prepared you are, the more fun you will have, and the more successful your audition will be. Above all else, show us your personality and energy at auditions - we want to work with people that are exciting and enjoyable to work with.
