

## **Battle for Branstrom Player Meeting**

Thank you for registering for the first ever sanctioned event at Branstrom Park. Battle for Branstrom. This event wouldn't be possible without our amazing sponsors, The Blind Squirrel Tavern, Michigan Disc Golf Company, @Home Computers, Joe Deur, Steven Headland and The City of Fremont for letting us use their park.

Please note this will be replacing the onsite Player Meeting. First round tee off time will be 8:45 am.

Hole assignments will be posted on <https://www.pdga.com/tour/event/78411> . Players are still required to check in on the day of the event at TD Central (MAP Below, Baseball Fields by Hole 22) between 7:30-8:15 am. We will be utilizing PDGA live scoring. Players can access the live scoring by opening their browser and going to [pdga.com/score](https://www.pdga.com/score). Once loaded enter access code "branstrom". Some notes about live scoring...

- All rules set forth in the Official Rules of Disc Golf Rule 808 Scoring are in full effect and must be followed without exception.
  - For the purposes of digital scoring, usage of the terms "turn in" and "return" shall mean "submit". Digital scoring is both official and authoritative.
- If an incorrect score is submitted and requires correction after the player has confirmed and submitted it, a two-throw penalty will be assessed in accordance with rule 808 G.2.
- Mobile devices should not be shared amongst players.
  - If score keeping responsibilities change hands the player currently keeping score should log out. Then the new player keeping score should log in.
- Players in a group may agree on a single player to keep score for the entire round.
- Discrepancies, provisional scores, or warnings for rules infractions must be recorded for each hole in accordance with rules 808 C and 808 E.
- Any time a provisional set of throws is recorded, the total score for the affected player should not be automatically submitted without a review and resolution by the event director.
- Each player must review and positively confirm their scores at the end of the round before the total score is submitted.

### Course rules by hole

Hole 1- On or over the paved road on the right side of the fairway is OB.

Hole 2- On or over the paved road on the right side of the fairway is OB.

Hole 12 - island. Must advance over of OB line short of the basket from tee. If missed, advance to the drop zone past the basket, towards hole 13. If you go OB from DZ, play from last in bounds.

Hole 15- On or over the paved road on the right side of the fairway is OB.

Hole 18 - Water deep of basket is OB

Hole 21 - Paved road/parking lot is OB

Hole 23 - NEW TEEPAD (DIRT) - Paved road/parking lot is OB

Hole 24 - On or over the paved road is OB. Grass island by turn around is safe

Second round tee times and hole assignments will be posted on [Battle for Branstrom | Professional Disc Golf Association \(pdga.com\)](https://www.pdga.com) within ten minutes of the final group finishing round one.

Please bring in the LP or CTP flag of your last hole of the second round to TD Central.

If no aces are hit the winner of Hole 12 CTP will win the ace pool. Please only sign the CTP flag for Hole 12 if you paid into the ace pool.

Hole 6 will be the 50/50 hole. Please only sign the CTP flag for Hole 6 if you paid into the 50/50 pool.

Hole prizes will be handed out at TD Central within 15 minutes of the final group finishing.

Am Payouts will be online vouchers to Michigan Disc Golf Company vouchers will be emailed out in a timely manner.

All cash prizes will be disbursed via paypal in a timely manner after the completion of the event.
