 - Cam: Taxonomy is shared, but when one collection wants to curate a specific Taxon differently, the solution is to 1) copy Arctos taxonomy into a new source that the collection can edit specifically
 - Dusty: doesn't recommend cloning all of the Arctos taxonomy because then you have to manage all of that taxonomy. Can instead create source for a specific group, and rank that one first; other taxa that aren't within that source will then default to the next source

- Is this ready to close? <u>identification remarks are overburdened and need cleanup#4922</u> Will leave open for other collections and Dusty.
- We closed this issue <u>Request addition to dwc archive published to IPT -</u> <u>dwc:scientificNameID#5814</u> but it's still in Discuss in Committee. Our records don't

show the Darwin Core field but the LSID is in the taxon metadata. OBIS no longer omits ~1,000 of our records because of homonyms so it's working ok and we could move it to Propose to Close. I would propose to close unless we want to pursue using the LSID as a means of dealing with homonyms. The OBIS issue is definitely resolved.

- Is this still a possibility? <u>Feature Request display_name (taxonomy / classifications)#6302</u>
 - The struggle is that every classification source is structured differently (WoRMS vs. others). Would be very, very complicated
- https://github.com/ArctosDB/arctos/issues/6523 Comment from July: "Until someone needs to use a subgenus as an identification this seems like something we don't need to deal with." We create strings almost every day to deal with (invalid) subgenera in the legacy IDs. Is there any other solution we're pursuing?
 - o DMNS:Inv makes identification strings to get around this issue
 - If a collection needs a subgenus as an accepted (#1) identification, then we'll need a better approach to subgenera. Currently, for DMNS:Inv, all the names with subgenera are unaccepted per WoRMS. We could close the issue for now.

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- LSID is in the classification, in production. In test: we are pulling the entire classification and metadata into flat from the source that is preferred from the collection.
- Possible solution: Add "dwc:scientificNameID" optional field as identification attribute. LSID can go in this field.
- OBIS is on the cutting edge of this data; more data will be coming into Arctos soon that will need this functionality.
- Question: how is OBIS treating this data? Do they have someone that can go through this? (Abby) GBIF has their taxonomic backbone, so they default to that.
- Ocean Genome uses the scientificNameID field from WoRMS as well
- -> Dusty thinks it's worth looking into the JSON first before defaulting to pulling the LSID into a field manually
- o Genna will file issue! Code table request (will do by end of day 2023-07-18)
