Animation	1=animation has been created, but there is not enough to tell the story and there are errors	2=animation has been created, but there is not enough to tell the story - or - there are errors	3=animation has been created for the entire story with no errors	4=innovative techniques have been used to tell the entire story without errors
Narration	1 = narration was incomplete; voice is too low and no expression was used	2=narration was completed but either voice is too low, there is not enough narration to tell the story, or no expression was used	3= the entire story is narrated in an expressive & audible way with storytelling voice	4 = the entire story is narrated in an expressive & audible way with storytelling voice; character voices, acting, or another vocal strategy has been used effectively
iMovie	1=iMovie elements have been used, but minimally and with errors	2=iMovie elements have been used, but minimally -or- with errors	3=iMovie elements have been used in an effective way to promote the theme of the story with no errors; all required elements are included	4=iMovie elements have been used in an effective, innovative, and error-free way to promote the theme of the story; all required elements + extras are included
Entertainment Value	1= work has been done in iMovie with Animation-ish imported, but the story does not include a beginning, middle, AND end	2= a film has been created with Animation-ish & iMovie that tells the beginning, middle, and end of a story	3=the film is memorable because of stellar storytelling voice -or- innovative elements that convey the story elements	4=the film is memorable because of stellar storytelling voice and innovative elements that convey the story elements
