Did you know?

- More than one billion people in the world today experience spine-related disabilities.
- The greatest burden of disability worldwide is attributed to neck and back pain combined.
 - Spine pain disproportionately affects women, the elderly, rural communities, and lower-income countries.

What is World Spine Care doing about it?

Over the past 10 years, 60+ volunteers have provided over 50,000 patient visits to individuals at the World Spine Care clinics located in communities with otherwise limited access to spine care. In addition, World Spine Care has provided educational programs for local health professionals, and through the <u>Global Spine Care Initiative</u> has continued to do and publish research to help others provide similar services.

What can you do?
