

WYO CLUB VOLLEYBALL - COACHES INFO

COACHES MEETING:

- Mandatory for all coaches and officials; will be held 25 minutes before pool play begins, at **7:35 AM**
- Bring your **printed roster from the TM2 event** and give to the site director at the coaches meeting
 - All players and coaches must have current AAU membership to be eligible to play
 - Players may only be listed on ONE roster per tournament day
 - Teams that list the same player on two rosters will disqualify both teams from the event
 - Coaches may add players with their AAU membership number to the roster at check-in
 - Coaches must cross out any players on your roster who are not playing that day
 - Players must keep the same uniform number for the entire event
 - If you have a shared libero uniform, you must **WRITE** that on your roster at check-in
- All players, up to 2 coaches, and up to 1 chaperone/scorekeeper listed on the roster get free admission to the event

FACILITY RULES TO ENFORCE WITH YOUR TEAMS:

- Water bottles with screw-on lids (leak and spill proof) are ok in gyms. **ONLY WATER allowed on courts.**
- Coffee cups and open beverages are NOT allowed in gyms. Unattended items will be immediately discarded.
- No one may play with volleyballs outside the playing gyms(s) - **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Do NOT allow players or parents into areas they are not supposed to be in, or to prop doors open.
- Clean up your team area! No food or drinks in the gym. Like camping rule: **You pack it in, you pack it out.**

COACH RESPONSIBILITY FOR EVENT:

- Bring your own warm up balls
- We provide R1 officials for every court (if not, then coaches must officiate)
- Every coach must be proficient in the role of the R2
- Please stress the importance of the entire officiating crew being focused and paying attention.
 - **Coach must ensure:**
 - No cell phones or electronic devices at the scoretable or with any of the officiating crew
 - No food or drink (other than spill-proof water bottles) at the score table
 - Line judges must pay attention and make calls during the game
- **SCORESHEETS must be done correctly with AAU/USAV format, by a certified scorekeeper**
 - U10-U12 teams must have a certified ADULT scorekeeper - no exceptions.
 - U13-U14 teams must have a certified ADULT at the table - a certified player can do the scoresheet
 - U15-U18 teams must have a certified scorekeeper doing the scoresheet
- Please help play move along QUICKLY by knowing when you play and officiate, schedule on TM2
- We will use a rolling schedule. Games start immediately after one finishes.
- No break between pool and bracket play. Medals are given to top finishing teams in each division.
- Teams are required to stay for officiating duties after a loss (and sometimes win) in bracket play.
- Teams are NOT allowed to leave until they check in/out with the site director.
- Please stay for a picture if your team places or medals!

EVENT DETAILS:

- **WARM UP:** teams will get a **2-4-4 warm up** before their FIRST game of pool play and bracket play. **1-2-2** after.
 - **Playing teams must shag for each other during warm ups; no ball handling when "off."**
 - **No shared serving.**
 - **2 minutes shared court (no serving), 4 minutes on (includes serving time), 4 minutes off (shagging)**
- **TIME OUTS:** Teams get two 30-second timeouts per set in pool and bracket play.
- **PROTEST:** You may protest any objective call or ruling during play. Penalty points will be awarded for excessive protest of calls determined to be subjective, or objective calls determined to be accurate.
- **U10s:** 5 serve rule will be used. 6'6" serve line must be taped off. Foot-faults must be called.
- Please remind your teams and spectators to be examples of sportsmanship!
