The vice of lust is a disposition of immoderate or immoral sexual desire.

God's design is for a husband and wife to frequently share their love through sexual intimacy in a way that is self-giving and respectful—attaching pleasure to the act so its desire creates more love, union, and life.

Lust, then, is not rooted in the desire for sexual pleasure, but in the disordered desire for it—without love, marriage, or dignity, but as an unresisted escape of indulgence by way of impure thoughts, eyes, and actions—eroding one's character, spiritual life, and relationships.

"Abstain from the desires of the flesh that wage war against the soul" (1 Peter 2:11); stand against lust with the virtues of chastity, self-control, and foresight.

Be chaste. Save sexual pleasure for your spouse alone.

Practice self-control. Bounce your eyes and mind from lustful sights and thoughts so as not to allow the temptation of lust to gain traction and lead to sin.

Use foresight. The devil knows when you are vulnerable and will attack in those moments; avoid situations where the grips of lust can more easily grab hold.

Above all, let your love for Christ exceed your love for lust.

Lust is difficult to defeat, but by the virtues herein and Spirit within, you can defeat it. If you fail, be sorrowful, but don't lose hope, or the devil wins—repent and return to the path of purity.
