Since moving to Columbus, I have worked with some of the city's most vulnerable populations including individuals and families with chronic housing and food instability. Columbus is a resourceful city that does its best to help community members in need but still falls short of providing stabilizing services for its most vulnerable. I currently work at a food pantry and am part of the ACLU of Ohio's Policy and Advocacy Team.

As a recent master's in social work graduate from OSU, I am committed to the Columbus Safety Collective Campaign's (CSCC) mission to stand up a non-police emergency crisis response team to support our community members experiencing mental health or substance misuse crises. Cities across the country are implementing alternative crisis response teams that are successful. We even have two programs already established here in Ohio, in Dayton and Cincinnati. The CSCC has been advocating for Columbus to reimagine public safety since 2020. Now is the time to take matters into our own hands and push for this policy change, but we need your support to ensure we collect enough signatures to get on the ballot.
