Click on the More icon in the opened email.

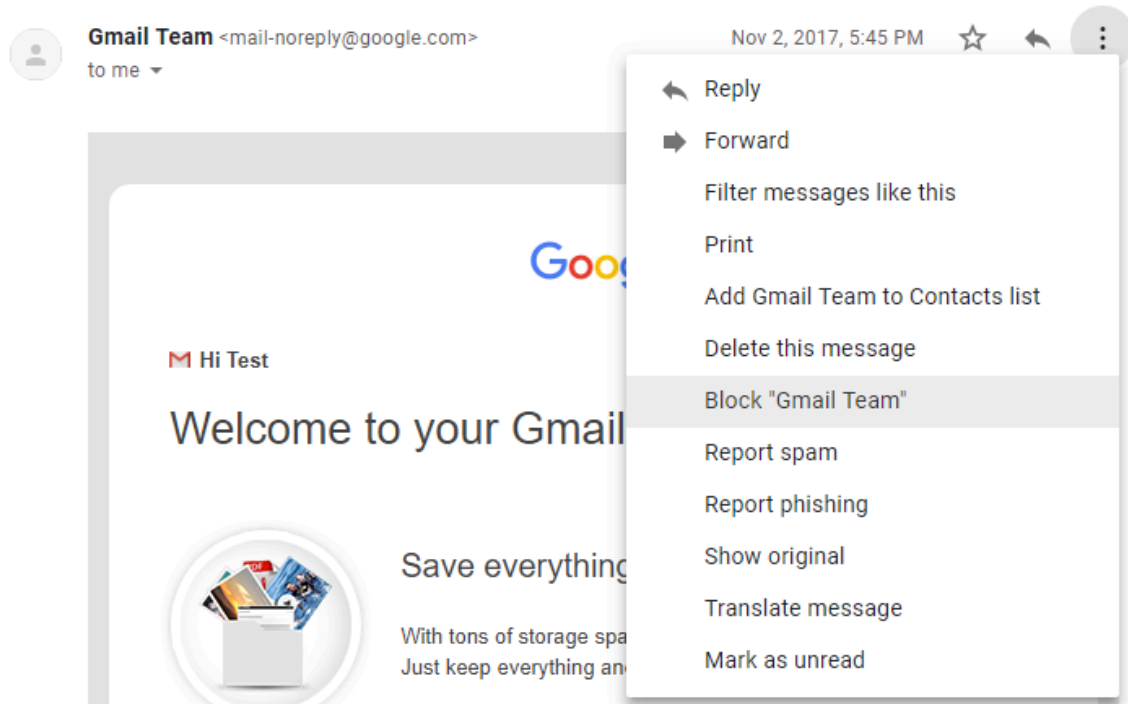


Click on the More icon in the opened email and select to either Block the email sender, report it to Google as a phishing or spam email (reporting as spam which will direct future emails into your spam label).

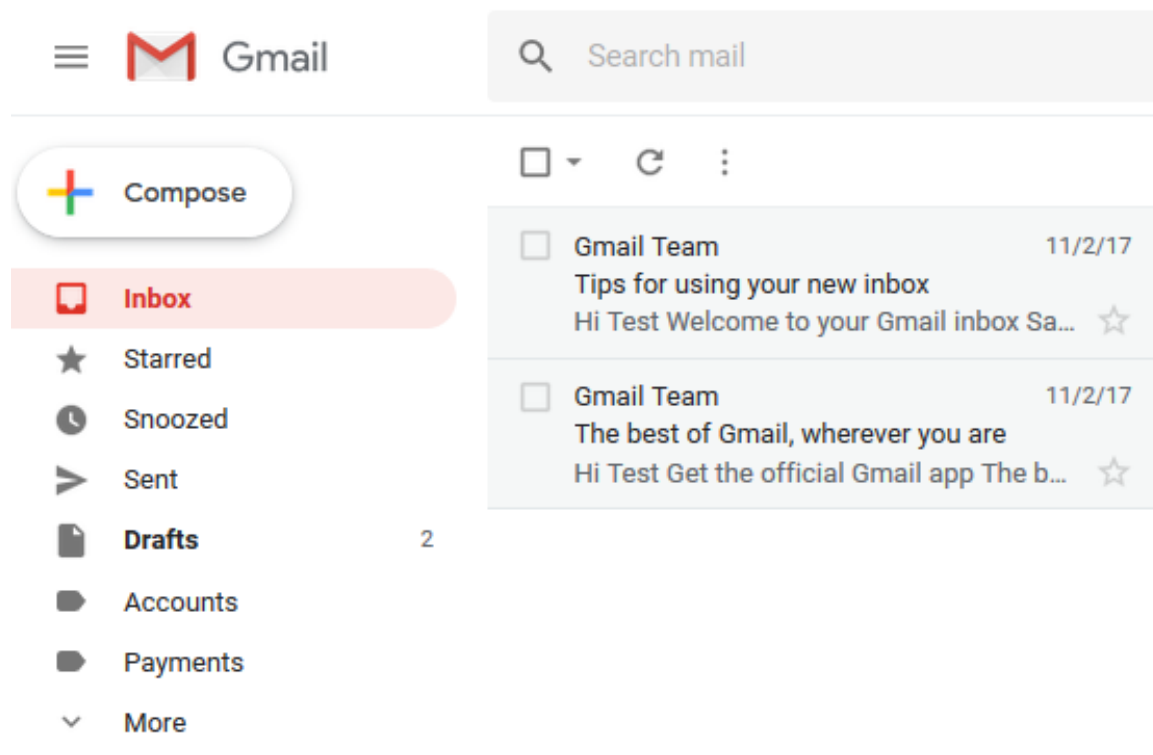
You can see which emails have been delivered straight to your Spam folder by clicking on More at the bottom left of the screenshot below and expanding the menu.

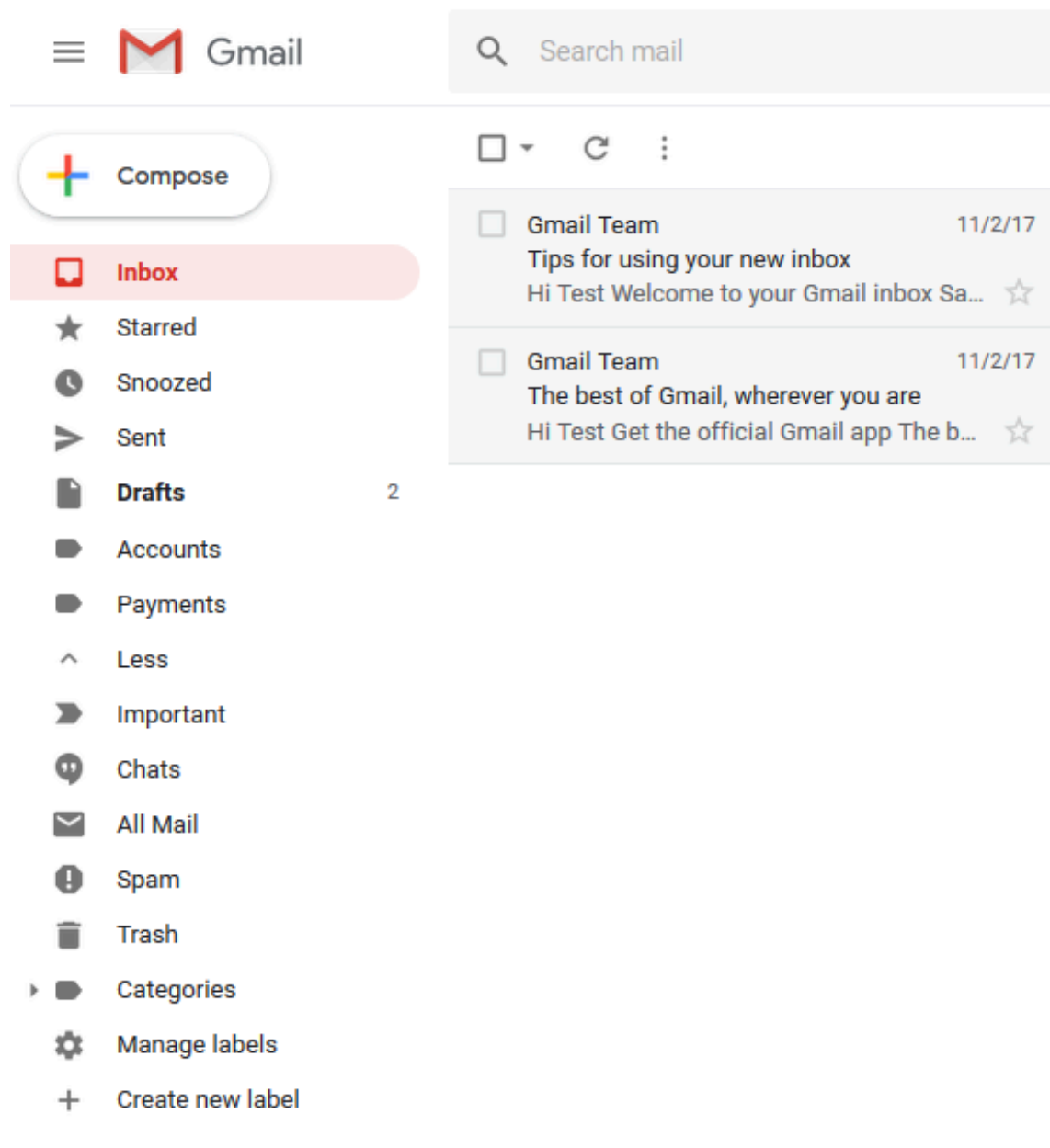
Click on the Spam label.

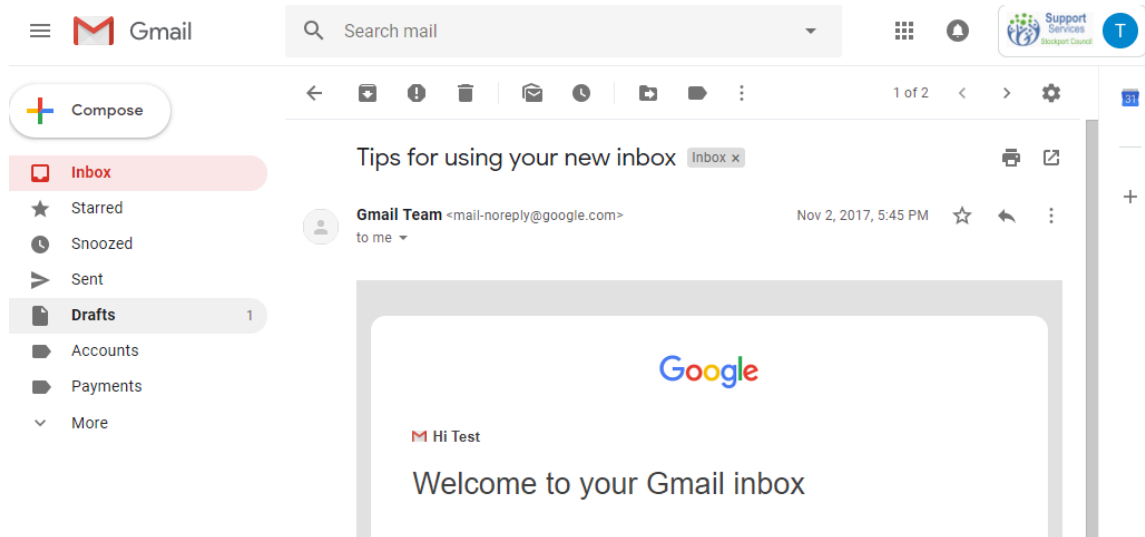


If emails are being incorrectly delivered into your spam label you can tell Google they are wanted by opening the specific email.
