# Los Rios Local Note: 591 (Repeatable)

## Purpose

The idea of this note is to allow us to add information of interest to one or more of our colleges that can be displayed as we prefer, e.g. either as a note in the item details or in the holdings area, brief display etc.

For notes displayed in the record details, this should be local information rather than information relevant beyond Los Rios. **Standard 5XX notes should be used for generally relevant/valid bibliographic notes.** 

If you just want to display a local note in the record details section, you are free to use 590 as a *local extension*, i.e. you must include subfield 9 with the value *local*. But we are encouraged, for better tracking, to use field 591.

## **Local Extension**

To add this field to an NZ- or CZ-linked record, you must add it as a local extension. If you forget to do that while adding the field, you can add \$\$9local to it and this will convert it to a local extension.

If you are using it with IZ-only records, such as technology bibs, you do not have to code it as a local extension. But for the sake of simplicity and consistency, you may choose to set these as local extensions, too.

## Subfields

Subfield	Mandatory	Repeatable	Notes
а	Yes	No	Value is always <i>Irlocalnote</i>
b	No	No	Text of the note.
d	No	Yes	Where you want the note to display (see details below). If left blank, the note displays below other notes in the records's <i>Details</i> section.
е	No	No	Expiration date for note in format yyyy-mm-dd

t	No	No	Link text. Only used if subfield u is present, and is in that case mandatory.
u	No	No	URL of remote resource.
V	No	Yes	Primo VE view in which note should be displayed.
У	Yes	No	Year in which the note was created, updated, or last reviewed.
Z	No	No	Local code indicating a type of note

## Subfield notes

#### a

The value of this field is always *Irlocalnote* with no punctuation or spaces, in lower-case letters. The purpose is to ensure that the note is created for our intended purposes and to help track in Analytics.

### b

The text of the note may include HTML tags, but be judicious. Using <strong> and <em> may be helpful but should not be overused. Multiple paragraphs and lists should be avoided. If more information is needed, consider using an additional 591 field.

If using quotation marks and setting the value of subfield *d*, use the HTML entity *&#34*; Instead of regular quotation-mark characters. Note that the MDE will show this as regular quotation marks, which will be confusing to look at and will make the field difficult to edit, because the cursor will not be placed correctly, so you might want to compose the note in a text editor and copy-paste it to the MDE.

If the note is displaying somewhere other than *Details* and you want to include a link in subfield b, be sure to add  $target=\"_blank\"$  to the anchor element. If using a link, you may want to use subfields u and t instead.

#### d

The note can be displayed in one of several places.

If you omit subfield d, the note will show in the *Details* section.



Note if you omit subfield d, only subfield b will show, and subfield v will be ignored.

#### **DetailsBottom**


Displayed under the details, centered on the page.

## HoldingsTop


Displayed above the holdings table.



#### Uses prm-opac-after

#### **HoldingsBottom**

Displayed below holdings table. If the user clicks through to a single location, the note will only be displayed if subfiled v is null or contains the library that owns that location. Also, if the record has only a single location, the note will only be displayed if subfield v is null or contains the library owning that location.




Primo VE directives: prm-locations-after, prm-locations-items-after

#### **ViewitBottom**

Displays at bottom of ViewIt area. This is appropriate for bibs that feature electronic portfolios and/or digital representations.

#### **Brief**

Displays in full display view in the area near jacket/icon, title, etc. These notes should be brief.

#### CollectionResults

Under thumbnail image on Collection Results page

e

Expiration date - the note will stop showing on this date. This may be helpful in cases when a note is associated with a course reserve. The format of the date must be *yyyy-mm-dd*. For example:

2024-04-02

t

Link text - text that displays for URL used in subfield u. Subfield u must be present in order for this text to display. Note that this text will typically be something like *More information*. The text should describe the resource that is being linked to. Do not use *click here* or similar. This link will appear after any note in subfield b. If subfield b is absent, it will still display.

u

URL leading to external resource. An external link icon will show. Subfield t must be present for subfield u to display.

V

View or views in which the note will be displayed. If omitted, the note will display in all views. Include the three-letter college acronym in lower-case. If including multiple views in the subfield, separate them with a space. Alternatively, include more than one subfield v.

У

Year in which the note was created or last edited or reviewed.

This note should be included if there is a need to group certain kinds of notes together. In Primo VE this will be added as a class name to the containing div, prefaced by *Ir-note-*. This class will allow you to add styles via CSS for particular types of notes. For the class to be added, you need to have a value in subfield d.
