Committee Updates

- TREASURER – Mary Szolomayer
 - o Budget ballots are ready to go. Waiting for Brenda to supply Labels for Budget Ballots. Carol needs to put together a Tellers Committee who will open and tally ballots returned for budget.
 - o Deposited Beachcombers donation check from Super 50/50 winnings.
 - o 4th Q taxes due Nov 1st.
 - o Need deposit receipts for debit card. Marian mailed some last week to Mary S and gave Carol one. Mike Randazzo also has receipts for grill and Costco purchases and will send to Mary S.
 - o Still need reports from all events for ABC from Mike Randazzo. Marian will email blank event report to Mike. Also need reports from Al G whenever the Bar was open (including Men's Club).

- o Bocce Playoffs and Finals were great. Open Bar for Football Game afterward also went well.
- o 2021 Bocce dinner will be scheduled in November sometime.
- o Waretown Firetruck with Santa and the Grinch will be coming to Skippers Cove on December 14th. The plan is to also have the Lighting of the Memorial Christmas Tree that same night. Bar will be open. Mike R will purchase live tree for the Memorial Christmas Tree and tie to fence to in front.
- o Santa and his sleigh will be riding around the community on December 18th. A social event will follow.
- o Breakfast with Santa (Men's Club sponsored) will be held December 11th.
- GROUND – Maria Barrows
 - o Met with Stephanie Gebhardt regarding the gardening committee. Shrubs need trimming and will be tackled in March.
 - o November 6th is the date to put away patio furniture and winterize the beach. Rain Date is November 7th. Brenda will send out mailchimp to the community asking for volunteers.
 - o Maria emailed Bob Sadowski asking about his donation of stone from his front yard for replacement under the clubhouse fence. Waiting to hear back from him.
 - o Bob Eid will donate his 10' gate to clubhouse for replacement of the rusted one at north end. We need to wait for Bob's fence to be complete and then replacement will commence. Help will be needed to replace the gate and then paint it.
 - o Maria will spray weeds by front door and other spots as needed.
 - o Problem with garbage picking. This might have been resolved.
- HOUSE – Marian Repice
 - o Dishwasher is fixed. Thanks to Bob Eid, Gary Parisi and Tony Recipe.
 - o Fire bucket for ashes was purchased and is in the shed.
 - o Fire Suppression system was inspected and approved.
 - o Pest Control sprayed this week.
 - o Ballast lighting is so bad it is not worth fixing. Marian acquired 2 estimates to replace all the fluorescent lights except by the front door. Marian will ask the Electrician chosen to get permit if needed to do the work.
 - o The floor is in bad shape and \$300 was requested to rent machine to strip, wax and polish and buffer floor. Bob Eid volunteered to do that with rental of buffer from Home Depot. Board was in agreement to go forward with this expenditure.
 - o Marian recommends that surplus at end of year goes to interior wall damage and windows for east side of clubhouse if there are sufficient monies to cover the cost of this repair.
- BAR – Al Giancola
 - o Bar is doing well. New bartenders are doing great. Men's Club Meeting is the next event and the bar will be open. Bocce Playoffs and Finals along with the Football game afterwards was a great success and the Bar did well.
 - o Plan to open the bar for the next Giants/Eagles game.
 - o Bar will be open for the Halloween Party on October 30th.
