### **Reports**

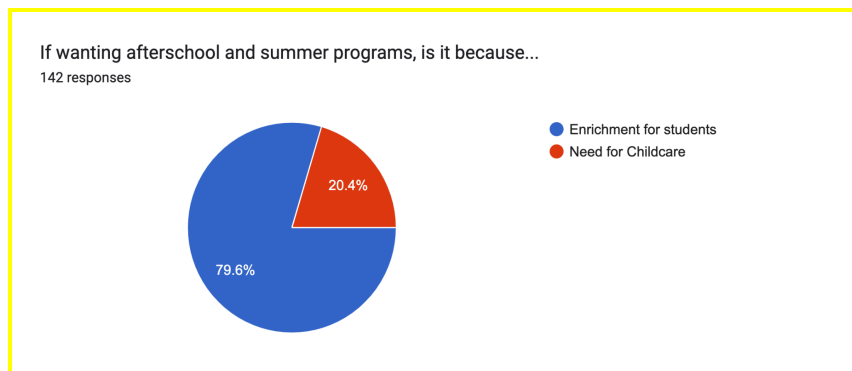
- **English Learner Advisory Committee** - Anne McCarty provided an update that though our ELAC families had ceded Legal Task responsibilities to SSC, the Multilingual office informed Anne that this is fine - but the requirements are that SSC needs to be made up of the proportionate number of multilingual students. SSC Elections will not be held until 2025-26.

- **Madison Community of Schools** - Anne McCarty provided historical context about prior Madison Cluster meetings and that the meeting on September 11, 2024 focused on new boundaries that won't impact Lafayette as the boundary shift is non-residential in nature. Anne also shared the historical context of CPMA and their move to truly be a magnet next year. There will be an audition process, but our students will still have every opportunity to attend CPMA in the fall of 2025-26.

### **Community Schools Council Funding Requests**

Tessa Wixon reviewed the one funding request and costs associated that were reviewed and approved at the October 10, 2024 Community Schools Council Meeting. **Saturday School Experiences/ In- school enrichment** - In an attempt to increase attendance while also supporting academics, Lafayette is seeking support from Community Schools for Saturday school experiences that can enrich academic learning while also connecting learning to real-world experiences (Community Based Learning). Buses average \$260 each X 3 trips, with tickets if necessary and approved by the Community Schools Central Office= **TOTAL UP TO: \$1,500**

- Pillar: **Integrated Student Supports & Expanded and Enriched Learning Time and Opportunities**
- Needs Assessment: **83 families wanted more academic enrichment, with 78% of families preferring enrichment over the need for childcare**
