



## **Dress Code for Prom:**

Prom is a formal dance for Senior and Juniors. Students and guests are expected to adhere to the following guidelines for their dance attire:

### **Girls**

- Dresses must be formal and floor length. (no high-low dresses)
- Senior girls are encouraged to wear a white dress.
- Dresses must be appropriately modest:
  - NO excessively low necklines
  - NO exposed undergarments
  - NO excessive slits
  - NO skin-tight or revealing dresses
  - NO cutouts
- Dress shoes (heels, flats, etc.) - Girls may bring alternate shoes to wear once the dance has begun.

### **Boys**

- Boys must wear a tuxedo and tie.
- Senior boys are encouraged to wear a white tuxedo/tuxedo jacket.
- Dress shoes
- Grooming must meet school dress code requirements.

If the attire is questionable, students are encouraged to show their formal wear to administrators beforehand to determine if it is dance appropriate. (You are highly encouraged to bring a picture before you buy it.) The determination of the appropriateness of student dress shall rest with the principal/assistant principals.

**Students and their dates who are non-compliant with the dress code will not be admitted to the dance or will be escorted out of the dance.**
