

Savvy Apron

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Chunky Knitted Snowman

Supplies

Chunky yarn

Size US19/15mm circular knitting needles for snowman shown or size US 35/19mm for a larger snowman.

Size US19/15mm double pointed needles or for snowman shown or size US 35/19mm for a larger snowman.

Size US19/15mm (or close to that size) regular knitting needles for snowman shown or size US 35/19mm for larger snowman.

I used a size 8 double pointed needles only for the nose.

Snowman Body

Cast 18 stitches onto size US19/15mm circular needles or size US 35/19mm for a larger snowman

Row 1: knit

Row 2:(k2 kfb) 6 times-you will have 24 stitches now.

Row 3: knit

Row 4:knit

Row 5:knit

Row 6:(k3 kfb) 6 times=30 stitches

Row 7:knit

Row 8:(k4 kfb) 6 times=36 stitches

Row 9:knit

Row 10:(k5 kfb) 6 times=42 stitches

Row 11 through row 43: knit

Row 44:(k5 k2tog) 6 times=36 stitches

Row 45 through row 64: knit

Row 65:(k4 k2tog) 6 times=30 stitches
Row 66:(k3 k2tog) 6 times=24 stitches
Row 67 (k2 k2tog) 6 times =18 stitches
Row 68 (k1 k2tog) 6 times=12 stitches

Cut off yarn, pull tail through remaining stitches and tie into a tight knot.

Snowman Arms

Cast on 6 stitches onto size US19/15mm double pointed needles for snowman shown or size US 35/19mm for larger snowman, dividing evenly on 3 needles.

Knit around for 23 rows.

Cut yarn, leave tail and pull yarn through remaining stitches and tie in a knot.

Nose

Cast 6 stitches on double pointed needles, dividing evenly among 3 needles. You can use any smaller size DP needles but I used size 8.

Row 1 knit

Row 2 knit

Row 3 knit

Row 4 knit

Row 5 knit

Row 6 (k2 tog) 3 times

Cut yarn leaving tail. Pull yarn through remaining stitches and tie in a knot.

Hat

Using circular needles, cast on 40 stitches.I used size US19/15mm for snowman shown or size US 35/19mm for larger snowman.

Row 1 through 10: knit

Row 11:(k6 k2tog) 10 times

Row 12:(k5 k2tog) 10 times

Row 13 (k4 k2tog) 10 times

Row 14 (k3 k2tog) 10 times

Row 15 (k2 k2tog) 10 times

Row 16 (k1 k2tog) 10 times

Scarf

Cast 9 stitches size US 19/15mm knitting needles (any large size knitting needles would work).

Knit in garter stitch until you scarf is the desired length.

Bind off.

Let's build him now!



Stuff the snowman as full as you would like with polyfill.



At row 44 on the snowman's body, you decreased stitches so that it would separate the head from the body.

Tie a string or thread around his neck and tie it in a knot.



Sew the hat, nose, and eyes onto the snowman.



Sew his mouth on with black or dark grey yarn.



OPTIONAL: I wanted my snowman to stand up straighter so I nailed two boards together from scrap wood.



I placed the boards through the bottom of the snowman.
