



If you work well in a team, work hard, like to solve problems, construct presentations and present material to an audience, then the First Lego League may be for you. Teeland Middle School is looking for motivated, enthusiastic, and responsible students to participate in an exciting opportunity to gain lifelong skills in robotics, problem solving, teamwork, and more. **First Lego League is a competitive robotic program for committed participants that are motivated to work in a team to solve problems, present material to an audience, create programs, work hard, and most of all have fun.** The team will meet on Tuesdays/Thursdays from 2:30 pm to 4:00 pm in room B209. The first practice will start on October 10th. Participants will work in small teams to complete robotic missions, construct a presentation on a topic (this year's topic is Master Piece), as well as construct a presentation on the FLL seven core values. TMS will be providing the robot kits and materials, but an activity fee of \$60 will be required to pay for ongoing costs.

This afterschool activity will be considered a team event and participants will be expected to focus only on FLL related activities. There will be at least one regional competition as well as the state competition located in Anchorage, students will be expected to provide their own transportation to events. If you are interested in joining the TMS First Lego League team and you have parental support and transportation; fill out a permission slip in the main office and pay the \$60 fee.
