ABOUT THIS ASSIGNMENT

What is this assignment?

You will demonstrate your ability to respond using crucial listening skills to a video prompt. Your responses should sound like you are talking directly to the person in the video.

These crucial listening skills are covered in <u>Ch. 9: Explore Others' Paths</u> of *Crucial Conversations*, 3rd edition, by Joseph Grenny, Kerry Patterson, Ron McMillan, Al Switzler, and Emily Gregory. You must demonstrate 4 types of listening responses, described by the acronym AMPP: ask, mirror, paraphrase, and prime.



How do I prepare to complete this assignment?

STEPS TO COMPLETE THIS ASSIGNMENT

Step 1: Record your AMPP Listening Skills Practice Demonstration in Achieve

How can I make sure I'm ready to record?

Use the "Try It Out" assessment, an OPTIONAL, UNGRADED practice that does NOT limit you to one take.
