- Hole 1: (on tee sign): casual area on the right side of the green marked in red (hobbit hole)
- Hole 3: there is a casual area marked in red in the fairway. Additionally, beyond the
 creek, there is a relief area marked in pink in the middle of the fairway to protect a
 buried turtle egg nest.
- Hole 5: MPO drop zone is the FPO tee pad
- Hole 12: The hillside just past the double mandos is now marked in pink as a relief area.

Round 2 Starter Notes

- Hole 1: (on tee sign): casual area on the right side of the green marked in red (hobbit hole)
- Hole 3: there is a casual area marked in red in the fairway. Additionally, beyond the
