Kids at Grace

Holy Communion

For those who have an intolerance to wine, grape juice is lighter colored on the tray, center. Those who find it difficult to walk to the altar can be communed at your seat. After the Pastor has given your group the blessing at the altar, you may place your cup in the basket and depart from the Sanctuary down the center aisle, and enjoy fellowship in the hall.

The Sermon - Body

Instead of treating the body as a means for selfish gain, Paul's message points to a greater purpose where our bodies are made into a holy dwelling for God himself.

THE FIRST LESSON 2 Chronicles 7:11-22

God promises to hear and heal a repentant Israel but warns that their disobedience and idolatry will lead to their destruction and the temple's rejection.

When Solomon had finished the temple of the Lord and the royal palace, and had succeeded in carrying out all he had in mind to do in the temple of the Lord and in his own palace, the Lord appeared to him at night and said:

"I have heard your prayer and have chosen this place for myself as a temple for sacrifices.

"When I shut up the heavens so that there is no rain, or command locusts to devour the land or send a plague among my people, if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land. Now my eyes will be open and my ears attentive to the prayers offered in this place. I have chosen and consecrated this temple so that my Name may be there forever. My

eyes and my heart will always be there.

"As for you, if you walk before me faithfully as David your father did, and do all I command, and observe my decrees and laws, I will establish your royal throne, as I covenanted with David your father when I said, 'You shall never fail to have a successor to rule over Israel'

"But if you turn away and forsake the decrees and commands I have given you and go off to serve other gods and worship them, then I will uproot Israel from my land, which I have given them, and will reject this temple I have consecrated for my Name. I will make it a byword and an object of ridicule among all peoples. This temple will become a heap of rubble. All who pass by will be appalled and say, 'Why has the Lord done such a thing to this land and to this temple?' People will answer, 'Because they have forsaken the Lord, the God of their ancestors, who brought them out of Egypt, and have embraced other gods, worshiping and serving them-that is why he brought all this disaster on them."

Reader: This is the Word of the Lord.

THE SECOND LESSON 1 Corinthians 6:12-20

Because the body is a member of Christ and a temple of the Holy Spirit, purchased by God at a price, believers are to honor God with their bodies. "I have the right to do anything," you say—but not everything is beneficial. "I have the right to do anything"—but I will not be mastered by anything. You say, "Food for the stomach and the stomach for food, and God will destroy them both." The body, however, is not meant for sexual immorality but for the Lord,

and the Lord for the body. By his power God raised the Lord from the dead, and he will raise us also. Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ himself? Shall I then take the members of Christ and unite them with a prostitute? Never! Do you not know that he who unites himself with a prostitute is one with her in body? For it is said, "The two will become one flesh." But whoever is united with the Lord is one with him in spirit.

Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a person commits are outside the body, but whoever sins sexually, sins against their own body. Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.

THE HOLY GOSPEL John 15:1-9, 17

Remain connected to Jesus, the true vine, to bear much fruit and glorify God.

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.

- 1. Paul says that while "all things are lawful," not all are "helpful." Can you think of a personal habit or behavior that might be technically "permissible," but isn't actually "helpful" in living out your faith or serving others?
- 2. Read 1 Corinthians 6:12-20. Paul reminds us that our bodies are the temple, a place for God to dwell and bring good news to others. How does this idea change the way we think about our physical and emotional health, and our relationships with others?
- 3. We were "bought with a price" and therefore belong to God. What are some specific actions we can take this week to use our bodies and our lives to serve others and bring them good news, rather than just serving ourselves?
- 4. Paul encouraged the Corinthians to "flee from sexual immorality." Beyond the obvious, what are some of the more subtle ways that selfishness or a desire for control can creep into our relationships, and how can we work to be more selfless and honoring to each other?

Cris's weekly input: Sermon Summary: Main Idea, Key Points, and Questions:

Pastor Cris's Summary:

This sermon on **1 Corinthians** focuses on the theme of unity and the proper use of the body. The speaker explains that in ancient Corinth, sexual immorality like sleeping with temple prostitutes was common and even seen as a form of worship. Some Christians adopted this mindset, believing their faith gave them the freedom to do whatever they wanted.

The sermon challenges this view by asserting that the human body is now the **temple of the Holy Spirit**. Just as Jesus cleansed the physical temple and became the new, perfect temple, Christians are called to be a new kind of temple—a place where God dwells and brings good news to the world.

The key takeaway is from **1 Corinthians 6:19-20**: "You were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body." The speaker argues that while "all things are lawful," not all things are helpful. Our bodies are not meant for immorality but for the Lord. We are connected to Christ, not to sin, and we must use our bodies to serve others rather than for selfish desires. The sermon concludes by offering forgiveness for past mistakes and encouraging Christians to use their bodies to build up those around them.
