

## **Courses at Butler High School**

These Advanced Placement (AP) courses are open enrollment with CMS Prerequisites and general recommendations listed. All AP students are expected to take an AP exam in May which will determine the credit that colleges will give for each course. Scores of 3,4 or 5 are guaranteed college credit at NC state universities. Each AP course also carries 1 quality point that is used to determine a student's weighted GPA in high school. While these courses may be offered each year, the number of sections will vary and are determined by staffing
