STAFF HEALTH

As a condition of employment every new employee of the School Board including teachers, cafeteria workers, janitors and bus drivers, must submit a certificate signed by a licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice registered nurse, or registered nurse stating the employee appears free of communicable tuberculosis.

After consulting with the local health director, the School Board may require the submission of such certificates annually, or at such intervals as it deems appropriate, as a condition to continued employment.
