Institutional Suitability	A visit to the partner institution specified in the agreement (or an exceptionally approved institution with prior approval) is planned.	15
Prior Consultation	Securing official acceptance from the host institution (e.g., invitation letter, official email) and clearly stating basic information (institution, visit purpose, responsible host) are required.	15
Visit Period	The Visit period is sufficient to achieve the objectives of the Outbound performance/Visit purpose (in principle, at least 30 days).	20
Clarity of Expected Outcomes	Expected outcomes upon completion of the visit are clearly and quantitatively defined, with clear completion criteria for at least 2–3 deliverables.	20
Activities Plan	Weekly or phase-based activities, roles, and resources (e.g., equipment, data, space, etc.) are clearly specified, with a high proportion of collaborative work that can only be conducted on-site.
