10. Regional Mentoring (Novice Teachers)

- NWAESC has a new vision for supporting novice teachers. DESE now requires an MOU between each district and the co-op detailing the support that novices will receive.
- All 1st, 2nd, and 3rd year teachers must complete the novice teacher registry. (<u>Linked here</u>.) We have been in communication with district novice coordinators to get this information; a big thank you to them for all their hard work! We are currently up to 691 novices in Northwest Arkansas!
- NEW: All 1st-year teachers must complete ethics training within 30 days of student-facing work. DESE requires that NWAESC collect and report this data throughout the year. Our first reporting date is September 22.
- NEW: All novice teachers must be assigned a mentor teacher for all three years of their novice experience. NWAESC is required to monitor this and report the information to DESE in our grant performance measures.
