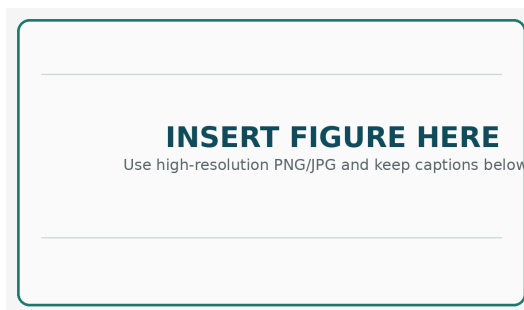


Figure 1. Example of a figure caption placed below the image
