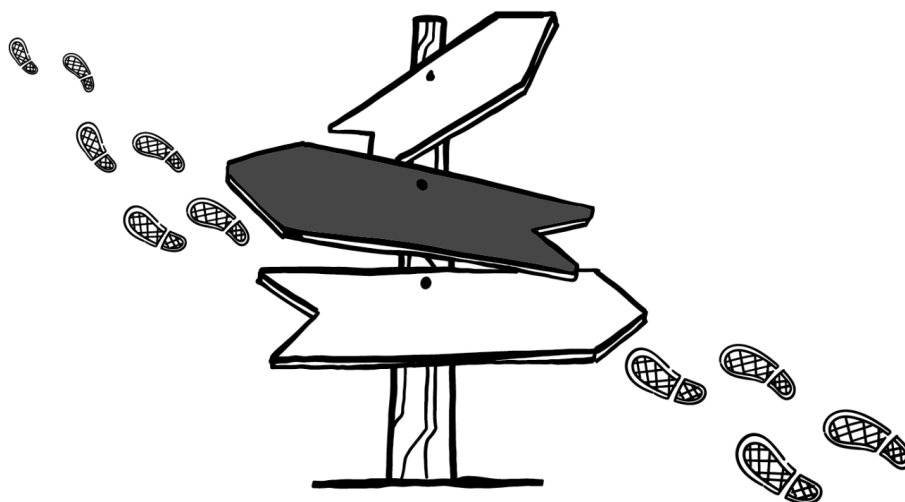

Kids at Grace

By the entrance into the sanctuary, busy bags are available for children to use. During the 10:15 service, before the sermon, Ms. Coli will take children (3 and older) to the other building for an engaging lesson about our hope in Jesus. Children are returned to their families right after the prayers. There is also a quiet room outside the sanctuary with toys and the live stream, if families need a place for younger children throughout the service.

Holy Communion

This meal is weird and wonderful: weird because we actually believe that the bread and wine are the Body and Blood of Jesus the Christ; wonderful because Jesus is with us. We take this meal very seriously here at Grace. If you have any questions or concerns, please reach out and allow us to answer your questions. **Children** who have not been instructed in the meaning of the Sacrament may come to the Lord's Table with their parents for a blessing but are asked to fold their arms across their chests to indicate they are to receive a blessing.

THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE COMMUNION: After the closing hymn, Pastor Scott will pronounce the sending and then for those who wish to share in the celebration of communion shall remain. ***For those who have an intolerance to wine, grape juice is lighter colored on the tray, center.*** Those who find it difficult to walk to the altar can be communed at your seat. Please inform the usher of your need. After Pastor Scott has given your group the blessing at the altar, you may place your cup in the basket and depart from the Sanctuary down the center aisle, and enjoy fellowship in the hall.

Serving Challenge

If Jesus offers a full and abundant life, then why does it feel as if words like burnout, exhaustion, anger, loneliness, unhappiness, and anxiety are winning the day? Something feels very off. A full and abundant life results in purpose, meaning, fulfillment, joy, and happiness. You were made for more than just believing and existing until you die. You were made to serve.

THE FIRST LESSON

Joshua 1:1-9

God commissions Joshua to lead the Israelites into the promised land, encouraging him to be strong and courageous.

After the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, the Lord said to Joshua son of Nun, Moses' aide: "Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them—to the Israelites. I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses. Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates—all the Hittite country—to the Mediterranean Sea in the west. No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be

with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you. Be strong and courageous, because you will lead these people to inherit the land I swore to their ancestors to give them.

"Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. Cris's weekly input: Sermon Summary: Main Idea, Key Points, and Questions:

Summary:

This document focuses on the concept of **compassion and action**, drawing from the teachings of Jesus. It emphasizes that true compassion goes beyond mere feelings of sympathy and requires action. The Greek word "splanchnizomai," meaning to be moved in one's bowels, illustrates the depth of compassion that leads to action.

The document explores how people often mistake passive emotions like sadness or anger for compassion, using examples like watching the news and feeling upset but not taking any further steps. It contrasts this with Jesus's active compassion, exemplified by instances where he healed the sick and fed the hungry.

The text also addresses the feeling of being overwhelmed by the scale of problems in the world, highlighting the story of Jesus feeding the 5,000. It concludes by emphasizing that individuals don't need to be saviors themselves, but they can act on their compassion and focus on helping one person at a time.
