Robious Middle Parents and Guardians:

This is a reminder that Tdap vaccine is required by law for all students entering seventh grade.

Tdap provides protection against tetanus, diphtheria, and whooping cough. Call today to make a wellness appointment with your health-care provider and get your shots updated. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, your health-care provider may be providing wellness appointments at limited times. So, don't wait to make your appointment.

GET THE BOOSTER SHOT NOW! Then, please provide a copy of the immunization record to your middle school as soon as possible.

The HPV vaccine is required by law for female students entering sixth grade. Parents/guardians may elect for their student to not receive the HPV vaccine with no additional paperwork required by CCPS. Ask your health-care provider about the benefits of the HPV vaccine.
