I'll show you one more time. How we got there, starting from our main menu, select pages and click into the blog where the post exists from here, click on the individual blog that you're going to edit and select this icon right here to open up your settings menu by selecting settings, you can navigate down to SEO, and this is where you'll enter in the SEO title underneath the title. You also have the option to add an SEO description up to 400 characters. When you've added the content you want to select save, and you'll be good to go
