## INTRODUCTION:

As ministers of reconciliation we live as Christ's ambassadors. We are able to do this because of the new life Jesus has given to us. Our life is now hidden IN Him and we are His "new creation. As we begin our 10 days in ONE ACCORD prayer for unity in our homes, church and community, we are taking our first day to pray for unity in our personal relationships. Take time today to do some reflecting on your walk with God. Take inventory of your soul, nurture the nature of Christ in you today. What needs attention in your own heart? Who needs attention in your own household? Praying with someone is such a wonderful way to build relationships and be together with Jesus!

### DAILY ONE ACCORD PRAYER

Lord, I lift up our love for one another as a body.

Help us purify ourselves by obeying the truth
so that our love for each other will be sincere, deep and from the heart.

May our love for one another prove that we are Your disciples.

Give us a spirit of unity so that we may glorify You with one heart and voice.
Help us accept one another as we clothe ourselves in love.

### INTERCESSION

As we pray in one accord for unity, what are ways that you are desiring to see unity in your personal life?

- Pray for yourself for strength to receive all the blessings of God, for healing and wholeness, for any neglected or unresolved issues of your own heart.
- Pray for the level of freedom in your life to grow
- Pray for healing of estranged relationships
