Queenstown Trip 2022 Information

Organisation

The trip will be run in conjunction with Edventuretours Group Travel Specialists.

A total of 20 students and 3 staff will be accompanying the students on the trip.

Other New Zealand schools have had an amazing response to similar tours to Queenstown and the Auckland Normal Intermediate community can feel confident that the students will grow as leaders within the school and gain immensely from the experience.

Costs

The estimated maximum cost at this time is NZ\$1299.00-NZ\$1459.00 per student, based on a minimum number of 20 students and 3 Teachers travelling FOC. Price is subject to cost increases and numbers travelling until booked and paid in full.
