
What is Pear Deck?

Pear Deck is an add-on for Google Slides or Microsoft PowerPoint and Teams that allows you to create interactive presentations and experiences for students. Student-paced and instructor-paced options allow you to determine who controls the pace of the learning as you gather formative feedback and guide student learning with interactive activities that are integrated within a presentation.

All Iowa teachers have access to free premium accounts for at least the 2021-2022 school year. All you need to do is <u>log in with your school email address</u>.


Getting Started with Pear Deck

- 1. Get the add-on
 - a. Google Slides
 - b. Microsoft PowerPoint Online
- 2. Create a new presentation or add interactive elements to existing slides. Add text, multiple-choice, number, website, draw, draggable, or audio elements to existing slides or use a customizable template to create a new interactive slide.





3. Start a student-paced or instructor-paced lesson.



4. Students join via code entered at <u>joinpd.com</u> or from a direct link to presentation.
