Starting from Vol. 15 No. 02, Manhaj no longer uses the footnote citation style. Manhaj has switched to in-text citations (**bodynotes**) following the APA 7th edition style.

Research article can adjust to the type of method used.

Qualitative can describe 1) type of research and type of data; 2) participants; 3) research process; 4) and data analysis techniques. (add as needed)
