York County 12U Baseball Guidelines and Responsibilities

General Information Updated January 2024

Area Representative Responsibility

- 1) Attending meetings and getting information to team managers.
- 2) Obtaining information for team scheduling.
- 3) Paying any fees associated with playing.
- 4) Submit rosters for each team. (This will be done electronically)
- 5) Make sure all teams are equipped properly. This includes a first aid kit, ice packs and scorebook.

Manager/Coaches Responsibility

- 1) Make sure all players are properly equipped.
- 2) Cancel games due to inclement weather. Call before 5:00 pm or a \$20 appearance fee will be owed to the umpire assigned. See umpire information form.
- 3) Schedule a make-up date for a rain out. Contact the opposing coach and agree upon a date and time within one week. Schedule the makeup date. See umpire information form.
- 4) Report score of each game through the website reporting link. Scores reported before 10 pm will be updated the same day.
- 5) Ensure that no tobacco will be present during the game. This includes coaches, players and spectators.

Note: Many fields are smoke free and if caught will be fined.

- 6) Ensure that no alcohol will be present during the game. This includes coaches, players and spectators.
- 7) Pitch counts should be followed for each pitcher. Anyone wishing to report a violation can do so through the website reporting link.

Here are the pitch count rules:

7-8 (50 pitches per day) 9-10 (75 pitches per day) 11-12 (85 pitches per day)

Here are the recommended days of rest:

- If a player pitches 66 or more pitches in a day, four (4) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 51 65 pitches in a day, three (3) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 36 50 pitches in a day, two (2) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 21 35 pitches in a day, one (1) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 1-20 pitches in a day, no (0) calendar day of rest is required.

General Responsibility

- 1) Remember this is for the kids. Play, have fun and learn. There are no scouts in the stands waiting to sign anyone, player or coach.
- 2) All coaches, players and fans shall conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner while participating in league activities. The use of profane or abusive language; unnecessary gestures; unnecessary roughness; or throwing of equipment shall result in the immediate ejection of the

individual from the game. The umpires shall report all disciplinary events to the umpire in chief. One or more disciplinary events concerning an individual may result in the removal of that individual from any further participation in league activities.
