Project: NACS guidelines for Sexual Education?

In this workshop we want to discuss the possibility of making a Nordic project and apply for finances for this, to agree on NACS guidelines for what to teach kids about sexuality and pleasure at which age. The guidelines could be in use for Health and Education Governmental bodies when making policies, but also for professional educators and health workers. The goal can be to submit these guidelines for a resolution at the next NACS annual meeting.

Come to the workshop if you are interested in teaching kids and youth about sexuality and pleasure. We will discuss our view on this, to see if we have common ground, and also if and how we want to run a NACS guidelines project.
