OUTLINE

The Nuclear Energy Legalisation Bill 2021 builds on the framework started by the Member for Cowper, removing the obstacles to the approval and construction of nuclear power plants in Australia. This Bill removes the final legislative hurdles to the legalisation of nuclear power in Australia. This bill will allow investment into clean and plentiful baseload power for Australia. It doesn't mandate that atomic energy needs to be a large part of our energy grid, it simply puts atomic energy as an option for our decarbonisation of our energy grid.
