



The Winter Droving Site 2023

Winter Droving takes place outdoors in Penrith Town Centre, which is a mix of paved public footpaths, asphalt roads, kerbs and cobbled areas. There is a traffic prohibition road closure through the centre over the three days.

Toilets

Public toilets are situated in Bluebell Lane and Sandgate Bus Station including facilities for disabled visitors and baby changing and there are also portable toilets at Great Dockray and King Street including one accessible toilet and further portable toilets at Bluebell Lane Carpark

Accessible Parking

There are accessible parking spaces in all town centre car parks which are operating as normal on the day. 4 additional Blue Badge Bays have been allocated on Burrowgate and Crown Square.

There is free festival all day parking at Ullswater Community College and Frenchfields.

Other Info

Assistance dogs are welcome at all locations.

There is no strobe lighting at Winter Droving however there will be flashing lights on some stages.

There is loud amplified music on some stages

Lost Child point is at the Eden Arts Information stall next to Clock Tower.

At any location, if you have any queries or require any assistance please speak to any Festival volunteer or steward who will assist you to the best of their ability or head to the Info Point sited at the Clock Tower in Market Square.
